

#### The Nightmare Before Christmas was based on a Poem!








### What 2 Wear


Another holiday that starts the day after Christmas is Kwanzaa. Kwanzaa is a nonreligious holiday to celebrate African heritage, unity, and faith. Kwanzaa lasts 7 days. On each day people dress in robes call Dashikis and Kaftans with a Kufi Cap. These robes are decorated in patterns with yellow, green, red, and black stripes. Beaded and gold jewelry is also very common.





Though Hanukkah is a major holiday worldwide with over a million people celebrating it there is no real uniform for the holiday. Instead, most Jewish people will dress in blue and white, with designs that represent Hanukkah, like the Star of David. One final holiday that is important to note is Bodhi Day. Bodhi Day is the celebration of the day that Gautama Buddha is said to have attained enlightenment. Bodhi Day is celebrated with meditation, prayer, and feasting. Most will wear colorful red, yellow, pink, and blue dresses and robes. But depending on the region they might wear Aoi Dai's, Sari's, Cheongsam's, or Hanfu's.
