District Goals for Student Achievement

- By SY29, increase by 2 percentage points the number of students performing at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY29, increase graduation rate from 89% to 91% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

East Cobb Middle School Goal(s) for Student Achievement

Goal 1

The percentage of 6th- 8th grade students scoring level 2 or above in ELA will increase by at least 5% from the 2025-2026 school year to the 2026 -2027 school year as measured by the BEACON Assessment (from 73.5% to at least 78.5%).

Goal 2

The percentage of 6th- 8th grade students scoring 2 or above grade level in Math will increase by at least 5% from the 2025 -2026 school year to the 2026 -2027 school year as measured by the Georgia Milestones (from 72% to at least 77%).

Teachers, Parents, and Students-Together for Success

East Cobb Middle School Teachers

Will work with students and their families to support students' success by:

- Teachers will provide extra help through our Reading & Math Literacy classes, as well as before the bell in-class tutoring.
- Teachers will provide strategies using emails and written Communication to parents for students who need support reaching their correct reading level.
- Teachers will post support materials, learning strategies, and test preparation materials for assessments on CTLS Learn.
- Teachers will regularly update grades in Synergy in the area of Science, ELA, Social Studies and Math and provide updates for parents if students need additional support.

East Cobb Middle School Families

Will join the staff to develop ideas about how families can support their student's success at home:

- Parents/Guardians will ensure students participate in tutoring for Math and ELA and respond to communication from teachers regarding additional support provided for students.
 - Parents/Guardians will regularly check teacher's CTLS Classboards and communicate via email or through written form with teacher.
 - Parents/Guardians will check CTLS Learn and or ParentVUE to see students learning strategies for all content area and preparation materials for assessments.
- Parents/Guardians will regularly check student grades in Synergy in the area of Science, ELA, Social Studies and Math, and ask students what they are learning in these classes and how it may apply to their everyday lives.

East Cobb Middle School Students

Will work with Teachers and their families by:

- Students will participate in tutoring for Math and ELA support. Families will respond to communication from teacher regarding additional support provided for students.
- Students will regularly check there CTLS Student VUE and communicate in class with teachers.
- Students will check with teachers for support materials and engage in strategies and preparation materials for assessments.
- Students will regularly check grades in Synergy in the area of Science, ELA, Social Studies and Math. Student will discuss with parents and teachers what they are learning in these classes and how it may apply to their everyday lives.
