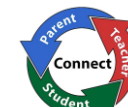

District Goals for Student Achievement

- By SY29, increase by 2 percentage points the number of students performing at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY29, increase graduation rate from 89% to 91% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.



Lindley Middle School Goals for Students

Goal 1: By the Spring BEACON Assessment, 6th–8th grade ELA/Reading teachers will decrease support needed by 30% from the Winter to Spring administration, as measured by BEACON Assessment data, specifically in the areas of interpreting text and the reading/listening categories.

Goal 2: By the end of the 2026-2027 school year 6th-8th grade students will increase levels 3-levels 4 on the Georgia Milestones Mathematics Assessments from 33% to 38% or higher.

Goal 3: By the end of the 2026-2027 school year 8th grade students will increase Levels 3 and 4 on the Social Studies End of Grade Milestones from 28% to 33%.
