Hightower Trail Middle School Student Code of Conduct for Virtual Learning

Virtual classrooms consist of real students and real teachers; therefore, appropriate behavior is expected. This Code of Conduct addresses student interaction with Hightower Trail Faculty and Hightower Trail student to student classroom interaction.

- 1. Students should address HTMS faculty and staff members as adults with the courtesy expected for education professionals. The expectation is that the appropriate title (Mr., Ms., Mrs., Dr.) and the last name only is to be used.
- 2. All communication, in written or oral form, is to be courteous to faculty and class members. Slang, or language from other environments, in written or oral form is not acceptable. Communication should be in complete sentences.
- 3. Students need to be aware of their background as they log into their classroom and check for a school appropriate learning atmosphere.
- 4. Students are to be dressed appropriately for attending school. Please refer to the HTMS handbook on the website.
- 5. No obscene, profane, threatening, or disrespectful language or images in any communications with faculty or other students is allowed and will come under CCSD Code of Conduct.
