

BEHAVIORExpectations

Number of CUMULATIVE Unexcused Tardies	Consequence
7 th cumulative tardy	Attendance office sends email warning to parent/guardian
12 th cumulative tardy	WEB detention assigned by administration
16th cumulative tardy	Administrative Referral, Saturday School assigned
20 th cumulative tardy	Administrative Referral, 1 day of ISS assigned
20+ cumulative tardies	Administrative Referral, Progressive discipline as assigned by grade level administrator

TARDY POLICY

**Tardies are cumulative over ALL classes!

WEB Detention – Assigned by your grade level admin to be served during WEB (either A or C block) in the lunchroom. Reminder sent to student during homeroom the morning of date assigned.
