District Goals for Student Achievement

- By SY26, increase growth by two(2) percentage points, for students scoring at the proficient or distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY28, increase graduation rate from 87% to 88%, as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

<u>LaBelle Elementary's Goal(s) for Student</u> Achievement

ELA Goal

The percentage of 3^{rd} grade students scoring proficient or distinguished on the ELA EOG will increase from 21% in May 2025 to 24% in May 2026.

The percentage of 4^{th} grade students scoring proficient or distinguished on the ELA EOG will increase from 22% in May 2025 to 25% in May 2026.

The percentage of 5th grade students scoring proficient or distinguished on the ELA EOG will increase from 31% in May 2025 to 34%% in May 2026.

Math Goal

The percentage of $3^{\rm rd}$ grade students scoring proficient or distinguished on the Math EOG will increase from 22% in May 2025 to 25% in May 2026.

The percentage of 4^{th} grade students scoring proficient or distinguished on the Math EOG will increase from 37% in May 2025 to 40% in May 2026.

The percentage of 5th grade students scoring proficient or distinguished on the Math EOG will increase from 28% in May 2025 to 31% in May 2026.

Introduce, instruct, and assign online resources according to student grade level.

Provide reading materials suited to student reading level.

Provide parents with strategies and materials to assist their child at home with math fact fluency & reading comprehension.

Send weekly updates on learning topics and special events via CTLS.

LaBelle Families Will:

Assist and support my child with the online resources provided by teachers.

Read 10-15 minutes daily with my child.

In 4th grade, use approved websites to practice reading and math by choosing activities that are just right for me.

In 5th grade, use materials to practice fact fluency.

Encourage my parents to check CTLS for announcements and messages from my teacher.
