

### **District Goals for Student Achievement**

- By SY26, increase growth by 2 percentage points, for students scoring at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY28, increase graduation rate from 87% to 88% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

# Osborne High School Goal(s) for Student Achievement

- Goal #1: By May 2027, the graduation rate of the FY27 cohort will increase from our current 74.33% to 78.39%.
- Goal #2: The total percentage of students scoring proficient or distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Algebra EOC will increase from 18.1% to 21.1%.
- Goal #3: Students scoring proficient plus advanced on the CCRPI English II EOC will increase from 26% to 29% (3% increase). Our goal is for 240 (826 approximate 10<sup>th</sup> graders) students to be proficient plus advanced by May 2026.
