District Goals for Student Achievement

By SY29, increase by 2 percentage points the number of students performing at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.

By SY29, increase graduation rate from 89% to 91% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Osborne High School Goal(s) for Student Achievement

Goal # 1- Grad Rate

By May 2027, the graduation rate of the FY27 cohort will increase from our current 79.3% to 80.9%.

Goal# 2- ELA

Students scoring proficient plus advanced on the CCRPI English II EOC will increase from 26% to 29% (3% increase).

Goal# 3- Math

Students scoring proficient or distinguished on the Georgia Milestones Algebra EOC will increase from 30.71% to 33.71%.

Goal# 4- Science

By May 2027, the percentage of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished (Levels 3–4) on the Biology EOC will increase by at least 3% from 28.8% to 31.8%.

Goal# 5- Social Studies

By May 2027, the percentage of students scoring Proficient or Distinguished (Levels 3–4) on the US History EOC will increase by at least 3% from 40% to 43%.
