#### **Definitions**

Adults - Any adult who works in the school and interacts with students.

**Bullying** – when someone is mean or aggressive on purpose and repeatedly to hurt another person or make them feel scared at school or during any school activity, such as waiting at a school bus stop, riding the school bus, or watching a school concert or sporting event. It can happen through words, actions, or writing, and it makes it very hard for the person being bullied to learn because they feel unsafe or uncomfortable at school.

*Cyberbullying* – when someone uses phones, computers, or the internet to be mean, threatening, or harass others online while at school or during online school activities. It can include sending hurtful messages or sharing embarrassing photos or videos.

*Teachers* - All teachers, including math, English language arts, science, social studies, art, music, PE, or any other school subject. Students should think about all their teachers when answering questions.
