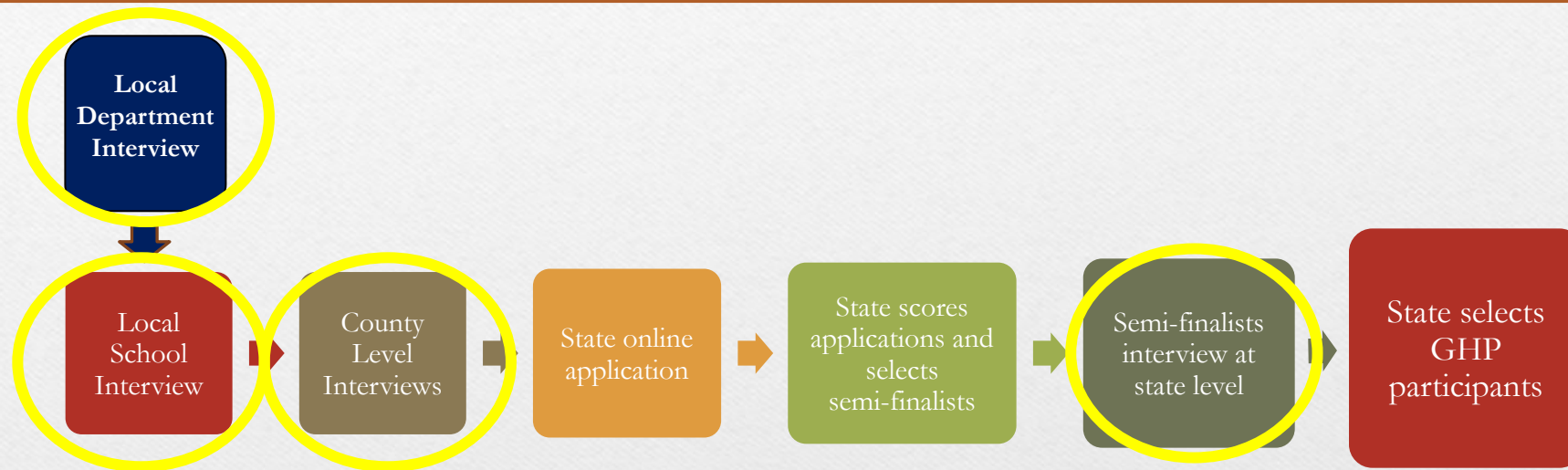

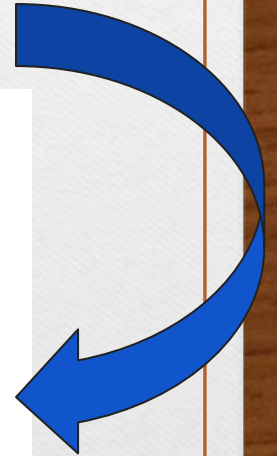
Process Overview
