- By SY26, increase growth by 2 percentage points, for students scoring at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY28, increase graduation rate from 87% to 88% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Green Acres Goal(s) for Student Achievement

ELA GOALS:

- In 3rd grade, increase the number of students scoring a 3 or 4 on the Milestones EOG assessment from 12% to 17%.
- In 4th grade, increase the number of students scoring a 3 or 4 on the Milestones EOG assessment from 23% to 28%.
- In 5th grade, increase the number of students scoring a 3 or 4 on the Milestones EOG assessment from 21% to 26%.
- Decrease the percentage of students scoring in the entering and emerging proficiency levels for the speaking domain on the ACCESS from 65% to 56%.

Set goals for reading achievement throughout the year and offer parent support sessions to assist with helping their students' literacy skills.

Monitor my child's reading progress by communicating with the teacher via CTLS and attend parent literacy sessions.

Accomplish reading goals that are set for me throughout the year.

Require students to read at home a minimum of 30 minutes per night.

Read to my child(ren) daily to reinforce fluency and comprehension.

Read with my parents for 30 minutes each day at home to increase my reading comprehension.
