

School Hours & Transportation Information

Morning Arrival

1. It is highly recommended that students arrive early (before 8:50 AM) only if they have a specific reason (appointment with a teacher, intramurals, tutoring, etc.)
2. No student should be dropped off before 8:15 AM; there is no supervision available prior to this time and the front doors remain locked until 8:15 AM each morning. Students who arrive early will report to our cafeteria and sign in for silent study hall.
3. Students should be in homeroom when the bell rings each morning at 9:10 AM to avoid being marked tardy.
4. When dropping off your child, please do not pull into the parking lot, instead pull up to the front of the school or the flagpole. At no point in time should a student walk across the parking lot. They should cross the drive at the crosswalk at all times.

Afternoon Dismissal

1. Early dismissals are accepted until 3:45 PM. If you arrive to check out your student AFTER 3:45 PM, please accept our apologies but we will not be able to call into classrooms. Students will be dismissed at the normal 4:15 PM dismissal time.
2. All last-minute transportation changes must be completed by 3:45 PM to ensure we have adequate time to communicate this with your student. For safety reasons, no transportation changes will be announced at the end of the day.
3. Students may not be picked up from the parking lot, but from either the front of the school or the flagpole. When making the turn, please make two lines, utilizing the last name directions on the pavement. Students may only cross at the crosswalk to get into their cars. If your child is not yet outside, please pull forward so that other students may get into their vehicles. Car riders are dismissed after bus riders, at approximately 4:20.
4. Students may also be picked up in the Frey lot. Parents must park and walk to the Frey sign, where students will be allowed to cross with a staff member at the crosswalk once it is clear the student has an adult picking them up. We will not allow students to cross and wait in the Frey lot.
5. Students should not be **picked up** in any other areas of the school. This is to ensure all students are safe during dismissal when there are many cars and buses attempting to depart. We appreciate your support in keeping all students safe.
