Lassiter High School was established in 1981 and is home to just over 2,000 students. We are a four-year public high school located in a suburban community within the greater metropolitan Atlanta area. We are accredited by the Southern Association. Over the years, we have repeatedly been awarded the Georgia Public School of Excellence award and have been named a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence.

Cobb County Schools: A District of Distinction

The Cobb County School District is the second largest school system in Georgia and the 28th largest in the United States. Its student population grows by nearly 2,500 each year. Continuing a strong tradition of excellence in education, student achievement remains the primary focus. This is evident in the "report cards" that annually evaluate the performance of Georgia's schools and school districts. Cobb schools have earned 13 National Schools of Excellence and 30 Georgia Schools of Excellence awards.

Curriculum

Due to the level of difficulty, some courses receive extra weight in calculating a student's grade point average (GPA). Additional quality points are calculated into the overall GPA and are not reflected in the numerical averages. There are two semesters in the August - May school year. Credit is granted for each semester independently of any other semester.

STEM Academy

The LHS STEM Academy is a competitive program with limited admission offering a rigorous inquiry and research-based education program focusing on biomedical and engineering pathways. The STEM curriculum culminates with student designed senior capstone research and internships connecting with local business and institution partners for real world experiences. LHS STEM students are required to take STEM specific science, math, and PLTW courses based on the pathway selected. Courses are completed at an honors or AP level.
