MID-SEMESTER INFORMATION



We hope you had a restful and enjoyable February break. Following this break, academics, athletics, and testing all begin to accelerate, and we want to share a few important updates with the Lassiter community.

We are now beginning the registration process for the 2026–2027 school year. This is an excellent time for students and families to discuss both academic goals and post-secondary plans beyond Lassiter. Your student's transcript, and the courses they choose for next year, should reflect the level of rigor aligned with those goals after high school. Before registration, we encourage families to review the [Lassiter Course Selection](#) website to research course descriptions, elective offerings, and pathway options.

Please keep in mind that our master schedule is built from student course selections made during registration, so this process is critical to planning for a successful school year. If you have any questions, please reach out to your child's teachers or counselor.

#### **Academic Information**

We encourage all students and parents to stay involved academically by frequently checking ParentVue/StudentVue and communicating progress with teachers. This is a good time to identify the need for any spring semester academic support and resources. In collaboration with students and families, we offer the following:

- **Academic Support:** We provide additional academic support resources such as tutoring and ASE to remediate skills and/or help students catch up on coursework. Tutoring services (listed by departments) can be found [here](#).
- **Communication:** It is strongly encouraged to maintain ongoing communication with your student's teachers to discuss their academic performance. Teacher emails can be found [here](#).
