District Goals for Student Achievement

By SY29, increase by 2 percentage points the number of students performing at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.

By SY29, increase graduation rate from 89% to 91% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Milford Goal(s) for Student Achievement

- The percentage of 3rd-5th grade students performing at proficient or higher on the Georgia ELA Milestones assessment will increase by 10% from May 2026 to May 2027.
- By May 2027, students in 3rd-5th grades will increase their level of achievement to proficient or advanced by 10% on the Math Milestones assessment.

Teachers, Parents, and Students-Together for Success

Milford Teachers

The primary teachers, specialists and support staff will work with your students to develop understanding of grade level standards.

They will: Provide books for reading 20 minutes nightly on each child's independent level; invite parents to an academic workshop to support the literacy standards.

Provide Parent Road Maps that explain and show models of the Georgia Standards of Excellence Math Strategies; provide an online license for XtraMath and iReady for students to access at school and home; invite parents to an academic workshop to support the math standards.

Provide writing activities to parents in all subject areas.

Milford Families

Families will: Read with their child nightly to support literacy standard; families will attend an academic literacy workshop. .

Review the Parent Roadmap's to better understand math strategies; Access Xtra Math and Splash Math from website and review math assignments with their child; families will attend an academic math workshop.

Provide time for students to write daily in all subjects.

Milford Students

Students will read daily at school and at home to strengthen reading comprehension and fluency.

Students will practice math daily by completing XtraMath and i-Ready lessons, practicing math skills at home each night, and writing daily across all subject areas to reinforce learning.
