WHAT IS NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY?

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO BE CONSIDERED FOR MEMBERSHIP?

Each potential member must submit a student interest form, along with two teacher recommendations/signatures. Each student interest form will be considered by a faculty advisory council. Upon the completion of this process, students will be notified of their selection status. Remember, each student's scholarship, leadership, service, and character will be considered during the selection process.

WHAT IS REQUIRED OF NORTH COBB CHAPTER MEMBERS?

North Cobb chapter members are required to pay annual dues and complete (and formally document) 30+ hours of community service per year. Additionally, members will be required to attend a formal induction ceremony and mandatory monthly meetings. Members who do not meet each of these requirements will not be honored with the National Honor Society stole at graduation.
