Logging-on to the Naviance Portal

1. Go to <http://www.cobbk12.org/>
2. At the top click "Parents"
3. Look to the left under "Resources (Cont.)"
4. Click "Naviance"
5. Use your Office 365 credentials to log in
 - a. Username: FirstName.LastName@students.cobbk12.org
 - b. Password: Use the personal password you created for school
6. After the first time you log-on go to the **ABOUT ME** tab. Under "My Account", **add your email address** to your contact information
