### Commencement Information and Schedule of Activities

Thursday, May 22, 2025, at 7:00 PM  
Kennesaw State University Convocation Center

It is important that you and your family review the following information carefully.

#### LOCATION OF VENUE AND DIRECTIONS

The Convocation Center is located on the Kennesaw campus of Kennesaw State University at the intersection of I-75 and Chastain Road. From I-75, exit at Chastain Road (Exit 271) and turn west. Go to the first traffic light past the I-75 ramps and turn right onto Frey Road for graduate or guest parking. For accessible and special assistance parking, continue to the second traffic light and turn right on Kennesaw State University Road. #### COMMENCEMENT TICKETS

- Tickets for family members and guests will be distributed to graduates on May 15, 2025, at the commencement practice.
- All guests attending the commencement, including babies and small children, will need a ticket to enter the venue.
- A photograph of a ticket (including but not limited to images on a cell phone) may not be substituted for a legitimate ticket.
- Lost or damaged tickets cannot be replaced.

#### SENIOR CLEARANCE

- All fees for lost or damaged textbooks, media materials, parking, classroom instructional equipment, uniforms, or any other materials owed to the school must be cleared by Wednesday, May 7, 2025.
- Fines must be paid in cash only.
- Students with outstanding fees will be prohibited from participating in the commencement ceremony.
- Senior Checkout will be Wednesday, May 14, 2025, beginning at 9:00 AM. All seniors must be cleared for graduation requirements, fines, and/or materials due prior to commencement practice.

#### FINAL EXAMS

- Thursday, May 8, 2025 – 3rd and 4th block exams
- Friday, May 9, 2025 – 1st and 2nd block exams
- Seniors will be allowed to check out after 2nd block on Friday if a senior contract with parent permission has been turned in **BEFORE May 7, 2025**. After checking out, seniors must leave campus.

## COMMENCEMENT PRACTICE

- Thursday, May 15, 2025 – Commencement Practice in the Osborne High School Arena, 8:30 AM – 1:30 PM (mandatory for all students participating in the commencement ceremony)
- Tuesday, May 20, 2025 – Technical Rehearsal at Kennesaw State University Convocation Center, 9:15 AM – 11:30 AM (for speakers, performers, and stage only)
- All practices are mandatory.
- Students who are late for ANY practice will not be permitted to attend the practice and must meet with the principal, Mr. Jones.
- Board and school policies (such as tobacco and drug/alcohol use, dress code, etc.) will be in effect.

## COMMENCEMENT DAY

- Thursday, May 22, 2025, 7:00 PM in the Convocation Center, Kennesaw State University.
- **Students** need to arrive at Kennesaw State and report to the Siegel Recreation Center by **5:30 PM**.
- Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. It is important to be on time for practice and the ceremony. Failure to be on time could result in a loss of your opportunity to participate in the ceremony. All Osborne High School and Cobb County School District rules, policies, and regulations will be in effect.
- **Ticketed guests** will enter the Convocation Center on the **Entry Level through the Atrium** on the **north side** of the building.
- The door will open at 6:00 PM for guests with disabilities and elderly guests requiring assistance.
- Doors will open for all other guests at 6:15 PM.

## PARKING




- **KSU charges a \$10.00 parking fee per car.** Guests should be prepared to pay with a debit or credit card upon entering the parking deck or lot.
- **Graduates** are to park in the Central Parking Deck. Graduates should wear comfortable shoes for walking from the Central Parking Deck to the Carmichael Student Center (CSC) and the Convocation Center (CC).
- **Guests** will park in the East Parking Deck and the East Economy Lot (across Frey Road from the East Parking Deck). Overflow parking will be available in the Central Parking Deck.
- **Guests with disabilities and elderly guests needing individualized assistance** should park in either Lot A or Lot B (as designated on the campus map). Golf carts will run continuously to convey guests to and from the Convocation Center.

## BAG CHECK

In accordance with Kennesaw State University requirements, all persons entering the Convocation Center must pass through metal detection devices. Also, guests entering the facility with a bag **MUST** use either a **CLEAR TOTE**, **PLASTIC ZIP TOP BAG**, or **SMALL CLUTCH** to be approved for entry into the venue. Please do not bring any packages that cannot be opened or inspected. Also, please allow extra time for entry as there may be delays.

KSU requires that all persons entering the facility must submit all bags for inspection by public safety personnel.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Any object which obscures the view or impacts the safety of others is not allowed in any district-managed venue. A complete list of prohibited items is available on the district graduation web page ([www.cobbk12.org/graduation](http://www.cobbk12.org/graduation)).
- Restitution for any damage to the venue, district property, or vendor property will be the responsibility of the graduate(s) and/or audience who cause the damage.

## FLOWER/GIFT SALES

Flowers and graduation gifts may be purchased from district-approved vendor(s) at district-managed venues. Sales kiosks will be located in the pre-function areas and/or outside the venue.

## COMMENCEMENT ATTIRE

Dress for graduates will be as follows:

- **Gentlemen**
  - Dark or khaki pants and neutral-colored shoes with a solid-colored dress shirt or collared shirt
- **Ladies**
  - Solid colored dresses (length no longer than the gown; collars should not show) or dress slacks, simple small jewelry, and neutral dress shoes
  - Sandals (no flip flops) may be worn but must be neutral colored without sparkles/bling.
- Each student must have a current commencement gown with a matching mortarboard and tassel. If you have questions concerning the items you have ordered, please visit [ATLGrad.com](http://ATLGrad.com) or call Herff Jones directly at (770) 795-1626.
- Remove your gown from the packaging prior to commencement and hang it up so wrinkles will fall out. Use a cool iron to press, if necessary.
- Mortarboards are to be placed on the top of the head so that the mortarboard is flat on top. Bobby pins are suggested to hold the cap in place. Tassels are to be worn on the **RIGHT** side of the mortarboard during the ceremony.
- To ensure the decorum of the ceremony and to provide consistency among schools, **alterations to the mortarboard and gown will not be permitted.** Graduates may only wear stoles, cords, and other insignia authorized by the school.

## CONDUCT

- Participation in commencement is optional and a privilege. Students must meet all expectations and requirements to participate in the commencement ceremony. No individual has the right to disrupt this event.
- Any graduates causing a disturbance or in any way conducting themselves inappropriately during the ceremony will be removed.
- Throwing caps in the Convocation Center is dangerous and not permitted.
- All policies, rules, and regulations of Cobb County School District and Osborne High School will be enforced during the ceremony.
- We ask that every guest please refrain from inappropriate noise and participate in a manner that will allow each graduate's name to be heard.
- Restitution for any damage to the venue, district property, or vendor property will be the responsibility of the graduate(s) and/or audience who cause the damage.

## COMMENCEMENT PHOTOS AND VIDEOS

- Guests are to remain in their seats throughout the commencement ceremony. Only hand-held cameras that do not block the view of other guests may be used.
- Guests may not walk into the aisles to take photographs.
- We have arranged for *BPI* to take an individual photograph of each graduate. *BPI* will mail each graduate a proof of this photo and ordering information.
- Videos will be offered for sale through the commencement information page on the district website. Please check [www.cobbk12.org/graduation](http://www.cobbk12.org/graduation) for more details.
- The school district will provide a live webcast of the commencement ceremony. The webcast will be publicly available via the school district website ([www.cobbk12.org/graduation](http://www.cobbk12.org/graduation))

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The School Counseling Office will be closed Monday, May 12, 2025, and Tuesday, May 13, 2025, so that counselors can verify the graduation status for all seniors. One of the counselors will contact you if there are any problems with your graduation status.
- Only school-approved cords/stoles may be worn during the ceremony. Cords for honor graduates (students with a non-rounded 3.500 Weighted GPA or higher) will be given to students at commencement practice on May 15, 2025.
- **FINAL TRANSCRIPTS:** Seniors will need to request a final transcript if they are planning to attend college. **Final transcripts are NOT sent automatically.** Students must request their Final Transcript to be sent to the college they are attending while completing the Graduation Survey in Naviance (see below). There is a one-time \$2 Senior Transcript fee that should be paid in MyPaymentsPlus. If a student has already paid that fee, they do not need to pay again. Final Transcripts are sent through Naviance to Colleges marked as “Attending” after graduation.
- As a reminder, the college that a student has applied to **MUST** be listed in Naviance under the “Colleges I’m Applying To” dashboard and marked as “application submitted”. CommonApp and Naviance accounts must be matched if a student applied through CommonApp. Please visit the School Counseling website (<https://osbornecounseling.wixsite.com/ohscounseling>) for instructions.
- **Seniors must complete their Class of 2025 Senior Survey in Naviance.** All seniors must complete this to be cleared for graduation. Seniors must have this survey completed before April 2nd. Final Transcripts are requested while completing the Graduation Survey. The survey will also ask for any scholarships that have been awarded. Please make sure you list all scholarships and amounts you have been awarded even if you are not attending that college.
- Diploma pick up will be Friday, May 23, 2025 in the School Counseling Office from 9:00am- 12:00pm. Diplomas may only be picked up by the graduate or the enrolling parent/guardian. Please bring a photo ID. Diplomas not picked up on this day will be available for pick up during School Counseling Office Summer Hours.
