Purpose:

The District believes family and community engagement is critical to student and district success. The establishment of Principal Advisory Councils is intended to provide a means by which parents, community members, and school staff can work together to create a better understanding of and mutual respect for each other's concerns and share ideas for school improvement. Minutes: Dr. Vaniman welcomed the group and reviewed the purpose of the PAC, norms, and the mission and vision of Rocky Mount.

Dr. Vaniman answered questions from the previous meeting. In regards to the sidewalk, SPLOST stated that the current crosswalk at the entrance to the building that takes students to the sidewalk is the most direct route to the front entrance. Students to not need to cross vehicular traffic once on site. This is the safest route for pedestrians to enter the campus. They do not recommend adding an additional sidewalk.
