Purpose:

The District believes family and community engagement is critical to student and district success. The establishment of Principal Advisory Councils is intended to provide a means by which parents, community members, and school staff can work together to create a better understanding of and mutual respect for each other's concerns and share ideas for school improvement.

Minutes:

Introductions were made. The purpose of PAC was discussed along with the norms and the mission and vision of Rocky Mount.

Dr. Vaniman shared the School Strategic Plan with the team. This year, Rocky Mount is focusing on strategies that help our students who already know the standard. The staff will be trained on strategies and ideas on how to accelerate students who have already shown mastery of the standard.

Dr. Vaniman discussed that we are a PBIS school. The pledge was said and the team discussed how students earn PBIS rewards. Participants asked about whether points go away at the end of the year. We tell the students to spend their points by the end of the school year. This year we will have a week where students can purchase rewards.

Dr. Vaniman discussed the Roadrunner Race and how it is our big fundraiser for the year to support our STEM program.
