District Goals for Student Achievement

- By SY 2026, increase growth by 2 percentage points, for students scoring at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- By SY2028, increase graduation rate from 87% to 88% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Lindley Middle School Goals for Student Achievement

Goal 1 -By the end of the 2024-2025 school year 6th -8th grade students will increase in levels 3 and 4 from 30.24% to 35.24% on the English Language Arts Georgia Milestones Assessment.

Goal 2-By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, 6th -8th-grade students will increase overall baseline data on the Mathematics Georgia Milestones Assessment by 3-5%.

Goal 3-By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, 8th-grade students will increase their scores in levels 3 and 4 from 28.8% to 33.8% on the Social Studies Georgia Milestones Assessment. By the end of 2024-2025, 6th-7th grade students scoring proficient and distinguished on interim assessments will increase from 10% to 20%.

Goal 4- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year 8th grade students will increase on levels 3 and 4 from 24.9% to 29.9% on the Science Georgia Milestones Assessment. By the end of 2024-2025, 6th-7th grade students scoring proficient and distinguished on interim assessments will increase from 10% to 20%.

Goal 5-By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, Lindley Middle Scholl students will decrease classroom disruptive behavior by 15%.
