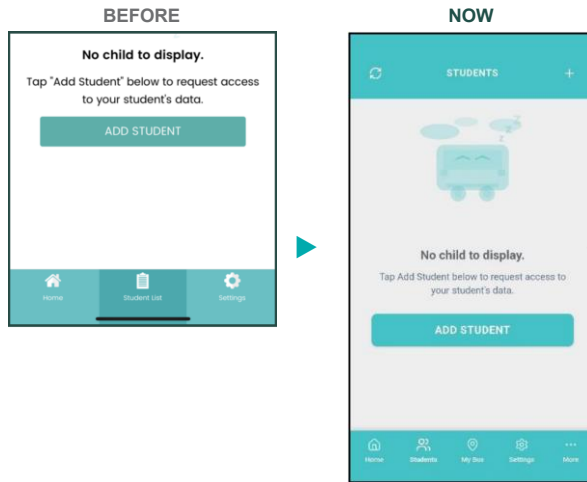

What's New: Previous vs. Current Version

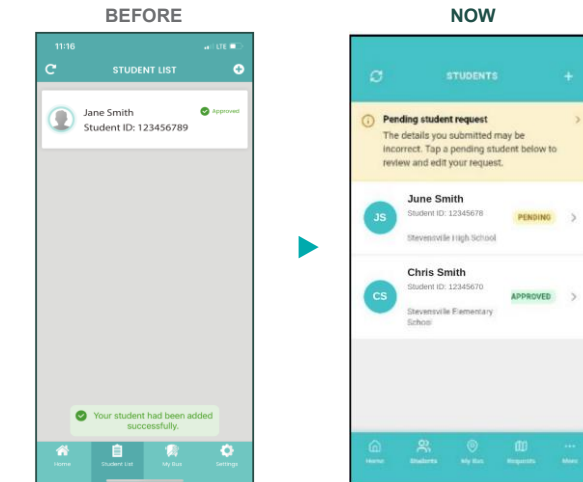
Note: This is not an exhaustive list of every change in the new Parent Portal. It highlights the most notable updates parents will see.

1 Add Student



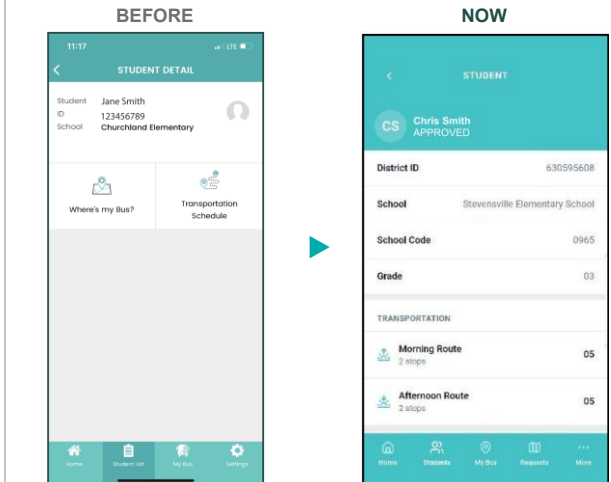
In the main menu at the bottom, **Student List** is now **Students**.

2 Approval & Pending



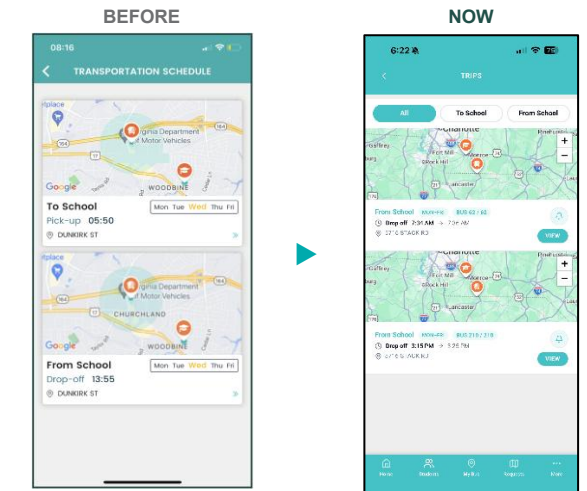
Pending requests now show an alert banner. To fix one, tap the request and select **Edit Request** instead of swiping left to delete and starting over.

3 Student Details



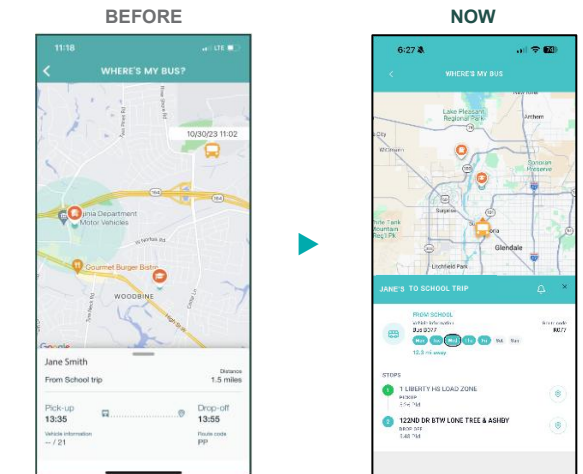
Details now include District ID, School Code, Grade, and the **Morning** and **Afternoon Routes**, all on one screen.

4 Trips & Student Options



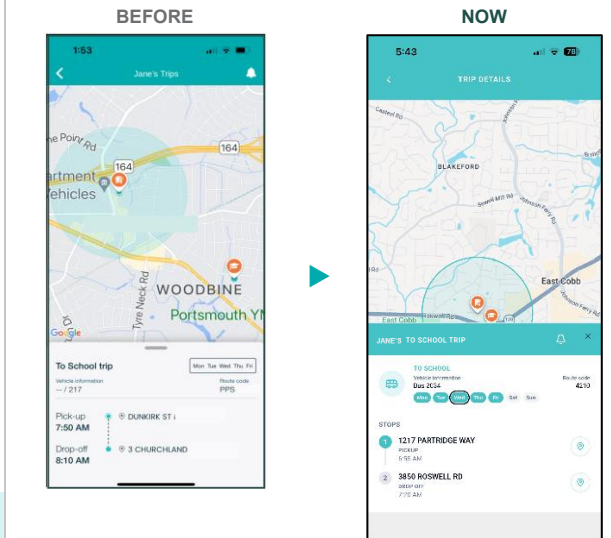
The Transportation Schedule screen is now **Trips**. Filter by **All**, **To School**, or **From School**. Each trip shows a map, the days it runs, the bus number, the stop time and address, and a bell for alerts. Select **View** to see more.

5 Where's My Bus?



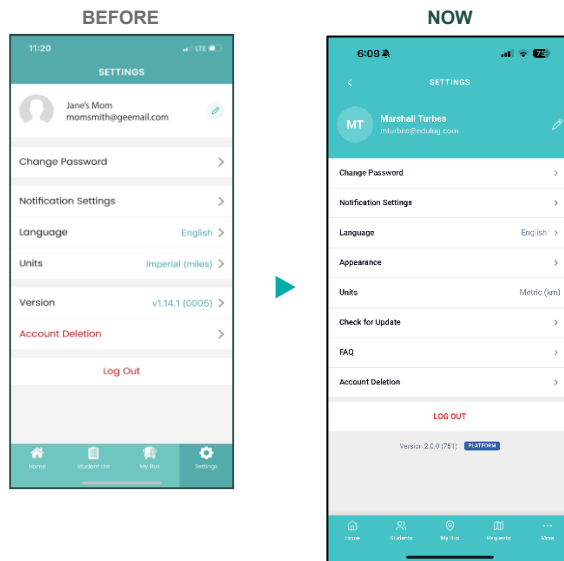
The map now opens with a trip details panel showing Vehicle information, Route code, the days the trip runs, and how far away the bus is. Stops are listed in order with their times. The bell icon for alert zones is at the top of the panel.

6 Trip Details & Bell



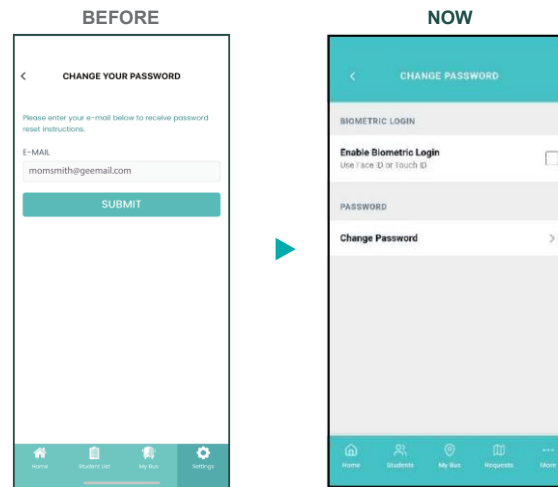
Select **View Trip Details** from the map to see the trip's days and stops. The bell icon for alert zones now sits on the trip details panel.

7 Settings



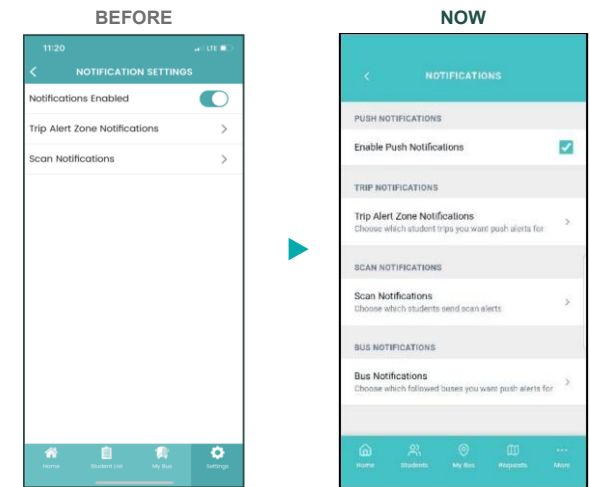
New options include **Appearance** and **FAQ**. Menu placement varies based on the features your district has turned on.

8 Change Password



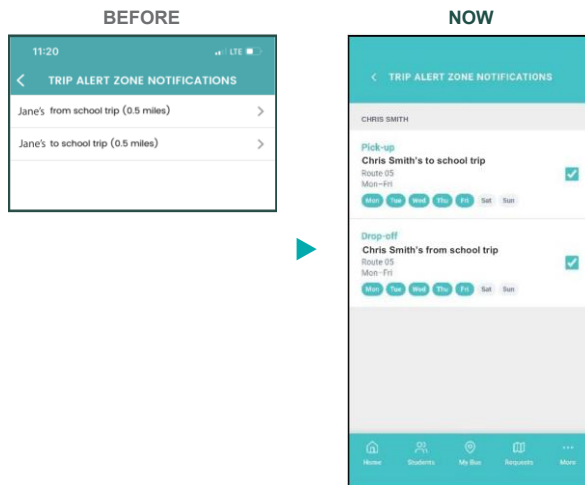
Adds **Biometric Login** (Face ID or Touch ID). Changing your password still sends a reset email from no-reply@edulog.com.

9 Notifications



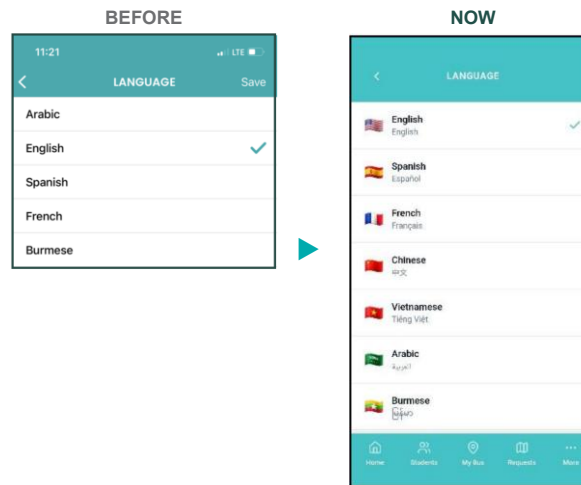
Adds **Bus Notifications** for followed buses alongside Trip Alert Zone and Scan Notifications. Push notifications now use a checkbox instead of a slide button.

10 Trip Alert Zones



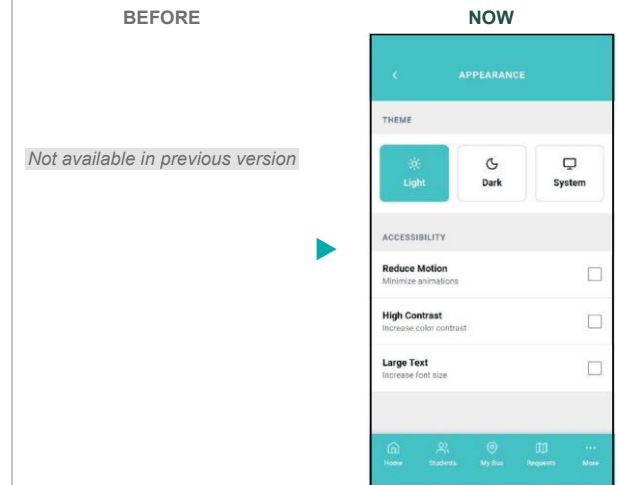
Each trip now shows its type (Pick-up or Drop-off), route, and days of the week, with a checkbox to turn notifications on or off per trip.

11 Language



The language list expanded to **15 languages**, each shown with a flag and its native name: English, Spanish, French, Chinese, Vietnamese, Arabic, Burmese, Swahili, Pashto, Dari, German, Japanese, Filipino, Korean, and Portuguese.

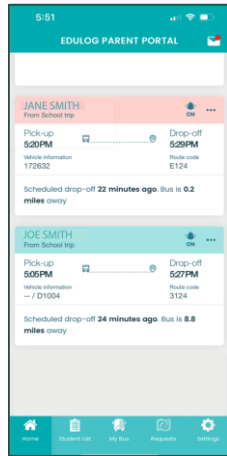
12 Appearance (New)



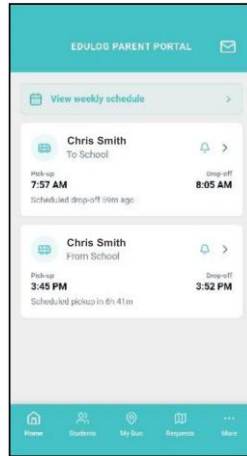
New feature. Choose a Light, Dark, or System theme, plus accessibility options for Reduce Motion, High Contrast, and Large Text.
