

Parking FAQ

SENIOR PARKING

Is parking guaranteed for seniors? At this time, we have enough parking spaces to accommodate our senior class, but students must follow all steps to attain a parking decal.

I've applied for parking but anticipate getting a new car, should I fill out another application? No. When you get the new car, fill out the front page of the parking application which includes all of the new information about your car. Bring that to Ms. LaVangie. If you already used the parking decal on the old car, bring \$5 for a new decal.

When/how do I pay for parking? All seniors should go ahead and pay for their parking spot on MPP. Be ready to show the receipt when you pick up the decal. Juniors - Parking fees should not be paid until you receive an email confirming that you have been assigned a parking spot. At that point you can pay fees through MPP.

If I can't be there for decal pick-up day, can I send paperwork with a friend to pick up my decal? No, but you could send it with your parent if they are willing to stand in line for you.

What if my car breaks down and I need to drive a different car for a few days? Put a note on the dashboard for Officer Quan to see.

What if I have a 2nd car that I want to be able to drive? After the first few weeks of school, you can fill out another Parking Application which includes information on the 2nd car along with \$5 for a 2nd decal. Bring these to Ms. LaVangie.

What should I do if someone parks in my assigned space? You should make note of the car parked in your space (parking decal, make/model of car, tag #), then park in Visitor's Parking at the front of school and inform the Front Office. DO NOT just park in another student or staff spot.

What if I park in the wrong space and get a ticket? You will have to pay the ticket in the Front Office. On the 4th ticket your car will be towed at your own expense.

JUNIOR PARKING

Is parking guaranteed for juniors? Please note that securing a parking spot on campus is not guaranteed for any reason. This includes being dual enrolled, participating in sports or other extracurricular activities, holding a job, or having appointments after school. Juniors should anticipate the possibility of obtaining a parking spot in either the first or second semester, but it is not assured that spots will be available in both.

When can Juniors get parking? Junior parking decals will become available once senior parking assignments have been finalized and decal distribution has taken place, typically occurring after the first two weeks of the semester.

Can Juniors get parking both semesters? Juniors will have the opportunity to apply for parking spots in both the first and second semesters. However, if the number of applications exceeds the available spots after seniors have been assigned, a lottery system will be implemented. If you do not get a spot in the first semester, you will automatically receive one in the second semester. Conversely, if you obtain a spot in the first semester, you will be included in the lottery but only after those who did not get a spot in the first semester are given a spot. Choose WISELY if your need is more critical for a particular semester!
