Pope High School <u>In-Person</u> Summer Physical Education Program June 2025

Registration begins March 7, 2025

Pope High School will be offering an in-person summer program for students to earn credit for Personal Fitness and/or Health. These courses are open to all Pope students, including rising 9th graders and other CCSD students. Space is limited and will be first come, first serve.

- > Students may take one or both courses for a half credit per session.
- > \$275.00 per course (.5 credit per course)
- All classes meet at Pope High School in the Old Theater. Students must be on time and ready to begin class each day.
- ➤ Due to construction in the building, students will be dropped off in bus port and will enter building through door by the loading dock. Specific instructions will be sent prior to 1st day.
- ➤ Daily attendance is mandatory. There are no excused absences and students who miss any sessions will be withdrawn from the class. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- More than three tardies will result in withdrawal from the program. A tardy of more than 20 minutes will be considered an absence and result in withdrawal from the course. Refunds will not be provided to students who are removed for attendance issues.
- > Students must provide their own transportation.
- No lunch is provided so students should plan on bringing a bag lunch, snacks, and water.
- ➤ Athletic clothes and athletic shoes are required for both courses.
- ➤ Writing implements, paper, and notebook are required. Other school supplies may be requested for projects.
- ➤ All Pope High School and Cobb County School District rules apply during the program.

- ➤ All students must register for the course(s) using the <u>Summer School Registration Link</u>. Payment Options:
- Current Pope High School students: Pay via My Payments Plus (MPP) or by cash or check. If taking both Personal Fitness and Health, you must <u>register for each course separately in MPP.</u> My Payments Plus.
- > Rising freshman and non-Pope CCSD students: Pay cash or cashier's check (payable to Pope High School).
 - No personal checks. Payments must be submitted <u>in person</u> to the Pope High School Counseling Office by May 2nd.
- Registration closes Friday, May 2nd; earlier if classes fill. Late registration will not be accepted.
