- Literacy Goal-** The percentage of students scoring at levels 3 and 4 in ELA content mastery will increase from 62% to 67% as measured by the 2025-2026 ELA Milestones.
- Math Goal-** The percentage of students scoring at levels 3 and 4 in math content mastery will increase from 72% to 75% as measured by the 2025-2026 Math Milestones.
- Positive Behavior Goal-** Mabry aims to reduce disruptive behavior infractions by 10%, as measured by the percentage of students receiving infractions from the 2025 school year to the 2026 school year.

Some are doing projects that didn't fit into the school year schedule, but some subject areas are struggling. The guiding coalition will look at options to address some of the issues.

**FEEDBACK:** students are using the PBIS store, but not as many as we would like. Also we need to look at the price of items. Would like to see a survey sent out to students to see what items they would like in the store. Possibly look at a PBIS game room.

**FEEDBACK:** counselors are going into classes and teaching coping skills as well as working with a small group called "Stress Busters." SOS has 45 peer lead suicide prevention program. They get training, help students identify a trusted adult, and do programs out in the skylight. Counselors are ASIST trained to help work with suicide training. Parents say students need training for how to report if they hear about student mental health issues. One parent was concerned that 8<sup>th</sup> graders are not connecting to the counselors.
