2025 – 2026 Content Integration Focus

Math Department: Geometry and Trigonometry

Questions in this domain measure the ability to solve problems that focus on area and volume; angles, triangles, and trigonometry; and circles. Questions include:

Area and volume

- Lines, angles, and triangles
- Right triangles and trigonometry
- Circles

Science Department: Problem-Solving & Data Analysis

Questions in this domain measure the ability to apply quantitative reasoning about ratios, rates, and proportional relationships; understand and apply unit rate; and analyze and interpret 1- and 2-variable data. Questions include:

- Ratios, rates, proportional relationships, and units
- Percentages, 1-variable data
- Distributions and measures of center and spread
- 2-variable data: models and scatterplots
- Probability and conditional probability
- Inference from sample statistics and margin of error
- Evaluating statistical claims: observational studies and experiments

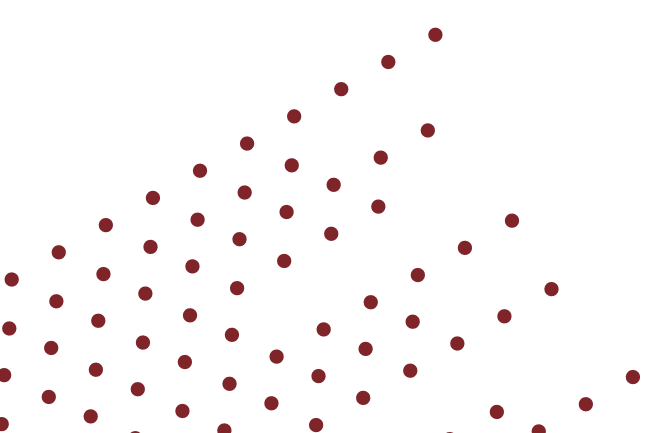
2025 – 2026 Content Integration Focus

English Department: Standard English Conventions

Questions in this domain measure the ability to edit text to conform to core conventions of Standard English sentence structure, usage, and punctuation.

Social Studies Department: Expression of ideas

Questions in this domain measure the ability to revise texts to improve the effectiveness of written expression and to meet specific rhetorical goals.



Understanding National Merit

National Merit Scholarship

The PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index score is calculated using a student's section scores and the following formula:

$$\frac{2RW + M}{10} = \text{Selection Index score}$$

NMSC uses PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index scores as an initial screen of some 1.3 million program entrants. Class of 2025 Cut Score: 219

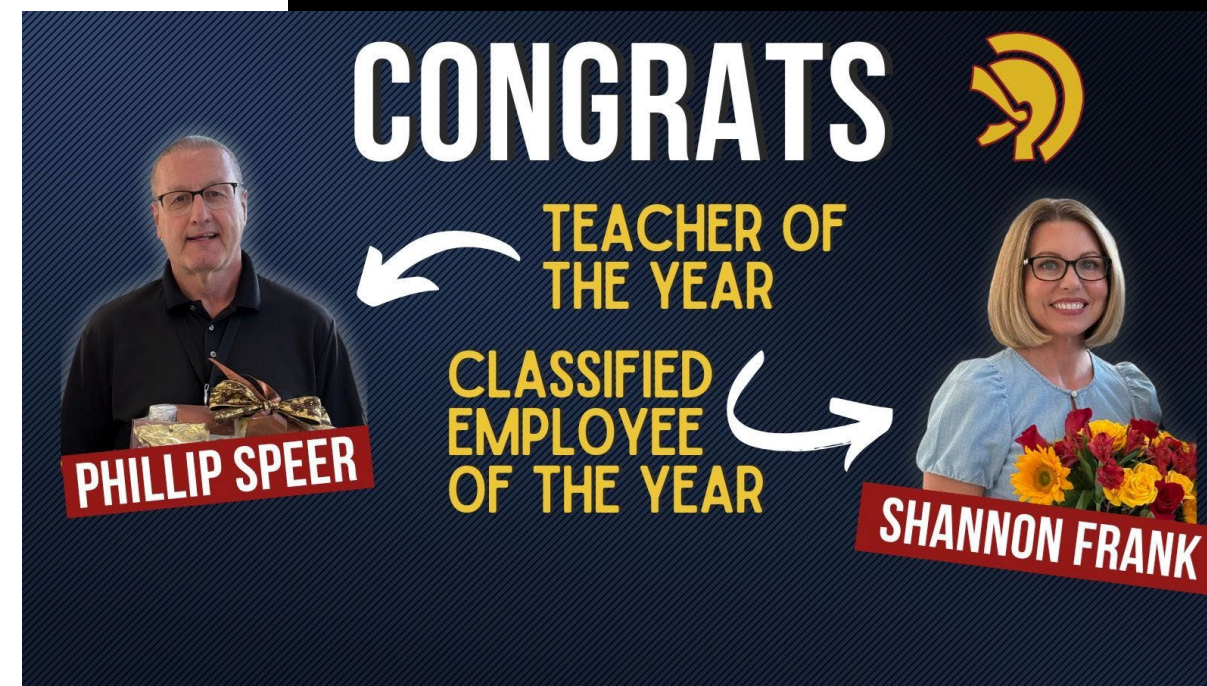

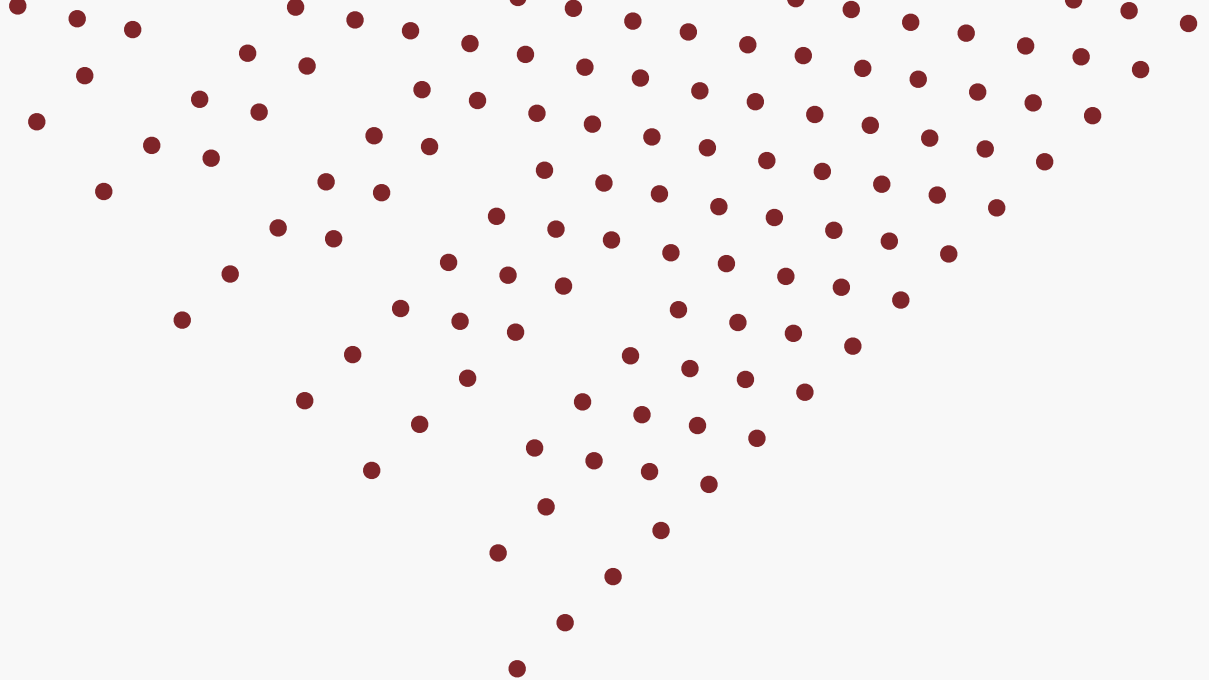
