Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports

An appropriate evidence-based method that creates an effective school-wide set of ideas and tools to improve the behavior of students for a more positive learning environment that includes improved academic and social outcomes for all students.

We ARE a Restorative Practices School

- Restorative Circles are proactive discussions that we use as a school to establish relationships and address underlying issues that intrude into the classroom and disrupt the learning environment.
- Restorative Conferences are a systemic approach for supporting students in conflict. The parties are brought together to discuss how the conflict has impacted each party and the larger school community. This practice invites shared power, mutual understanding, self-responsibility and agreed actions that repair harm, restore relationships and reintegrate the school community.

DLI

- Spanish Language (High School)
- Social Studies in Spanish
- The dual language immersion experience incorporates two languages into instruction.
- Typically, DLI is taught in a 50/50 model where half the day is spent in the target language.
- Students from either native language basically acquire the target language after success in the program.
