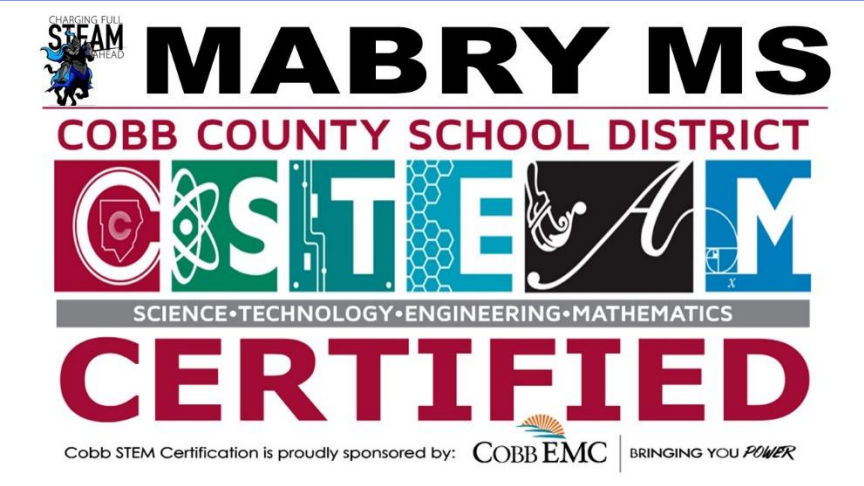

Academic Class Placement

- Class placement is based on IOWA test scores and the Advanced Content matrix on the Mabry website.
- Gifted identified students will be placed in at least one AC class but may be placed in more relative to their academic strengths.
- Students receiving special education services will be placed in classes according to their IEP.

SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES

- Students will be assigned an IEP case manager who will be responsible for conducting your child's annual IEP.
- The assigned special education teacher will contact you prior to Charger Day to introduce themselves and discuss any questions you may have.
- Once your student is assigned an IEP case manager, they will be your point of contact for IEP related questions/concerns.
- IEP and classroom accommodations will be reviewed and shared with your student's teachers before the first day of school.

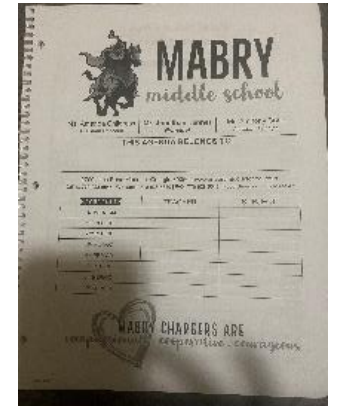

Accomplishments

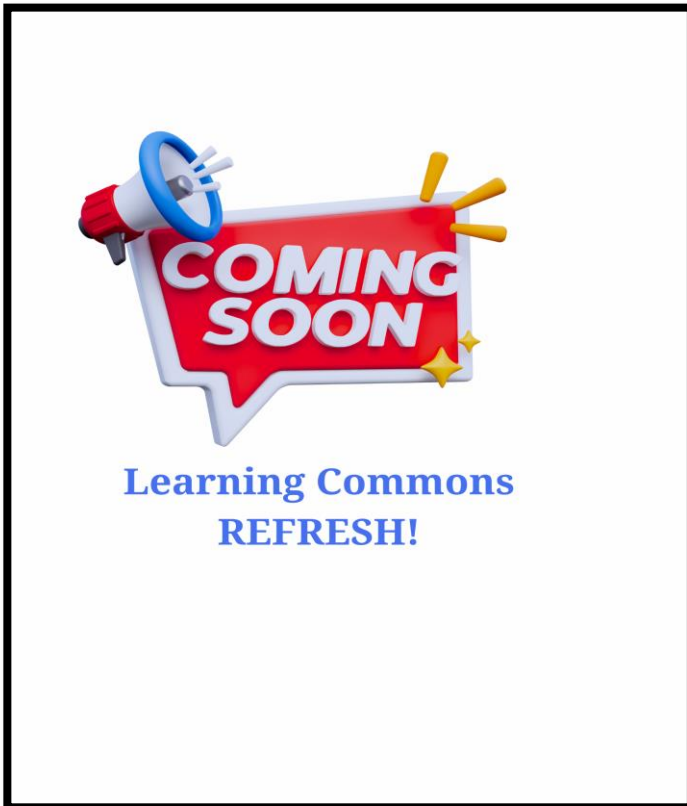
- Funded over \$14K teacher grants for 2024-2025 school year.

- Secured sponsor for 8th Grade Reality U, a financial literacy program



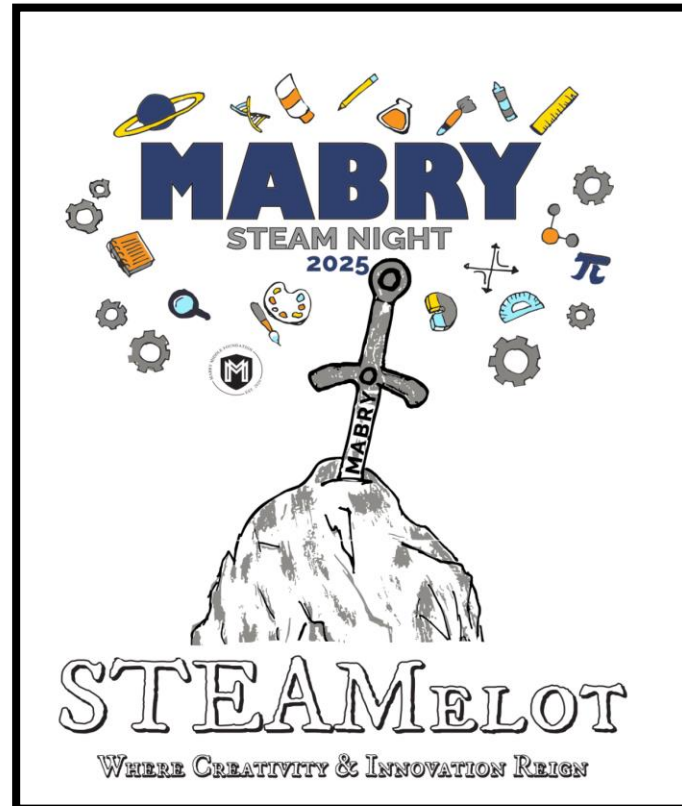

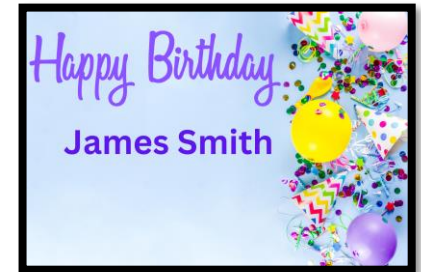

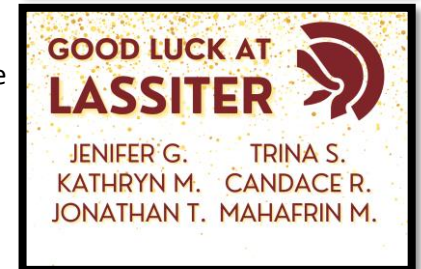
