

- STEAM instruction supports many areas of student achievement:

POSITIVE BEHAVIOR REWARDS




- Students are taught our behavior expectations for the classroom, hallway, bathrooms, theater, and cafeteria.


Our goal is to encourage family engagement & support, celebrate student success, and collaborate with the school to provide teacher support.
