Each Academy has a selective application process that involves teacher recommendations, interviews, as well as course and grade pre-requisites.

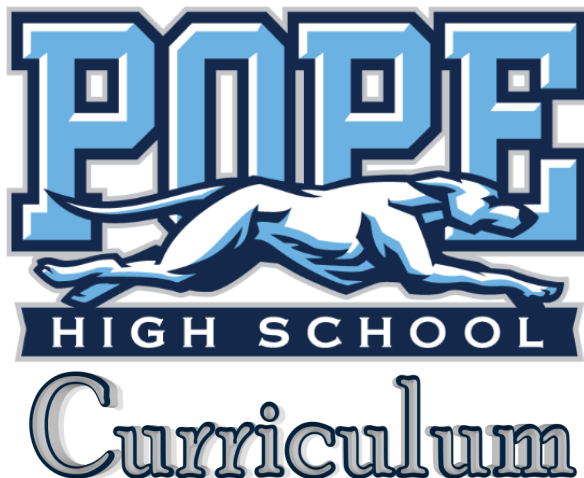
