

Senior Contract



Class of 2026

I agree to abide by the following items of this Senior Contract for the duration of my senior year, specifically as it relates to all school activities including, but not limited to, sporting events, after-school events, senior activities including commencement and prom.

- 1. I am aware that this conduct agreement goes into effect upon receiving it. Behavior and performance are monitored from August 4, 2025, to May 20, 2026.
- 2. Being recognized by an administrator for exhibiting positive behavior and actions may result in reduced fees for activities and events and other rewards.
- 3. Proper behavior and academic success are constant expectations; therefore, I understand that any of the following may result in my not being able to participate in senior events including sporting events, homecoming, Prom, and Commencement. This list is not exhaustive.
 - a. Fighting
 - b. Not passing classes
 - c. Violation of level 3 or higher or the Student Code of Conduct
 - d. Not meeting school financial obligations (i.e., fines, books, etc.)
 - e. Truancy
 - f. Senior Pranks
 - g. Drugs and/or alcohol
- 4. The person I choose to invite to a school function such as a dance, whether a Pebblebrook student or from another high school, is subject to the same rules. I will be held responsible for my guest's behavior and choices.
- 5. I will attend commencement practice. If I do not attend commencement practice without prior written approval by Dr. Dixson, I will not be allowed to participate in the graduation commencement ceremony or receive my tickets.
- 6. If my conduct during rehearsal and/or commencement becomes disruptive, I could be removed from the ceremonies and will need a conference with Dr. G. prior to receiving my diploma. This includes taking out flags or wearing unapproved regalia.
- 7. I understand that if I cannot go to activities or ceremonies because of behavior, I will not receive a refund for those events.
- 8. If you have parking privileges and you leave campus, you will lose parking privileges for the remainder of the year and receive administrative discipline. If you are a passenger and you leave campus, you will not be eligible for parking privileges and face administrative discipline.

 processes for college applications (Naviance), military enlistments, and steps to enter a

 - Seniors MUST use Naviance if they are applying to any type of college. Naviance is an online tool which serves as the vehical to send necessary documents to colleges from high school officials like transcripts, letters of recommendation, etc. Seniors access it via Clever and do not need a separate login.
