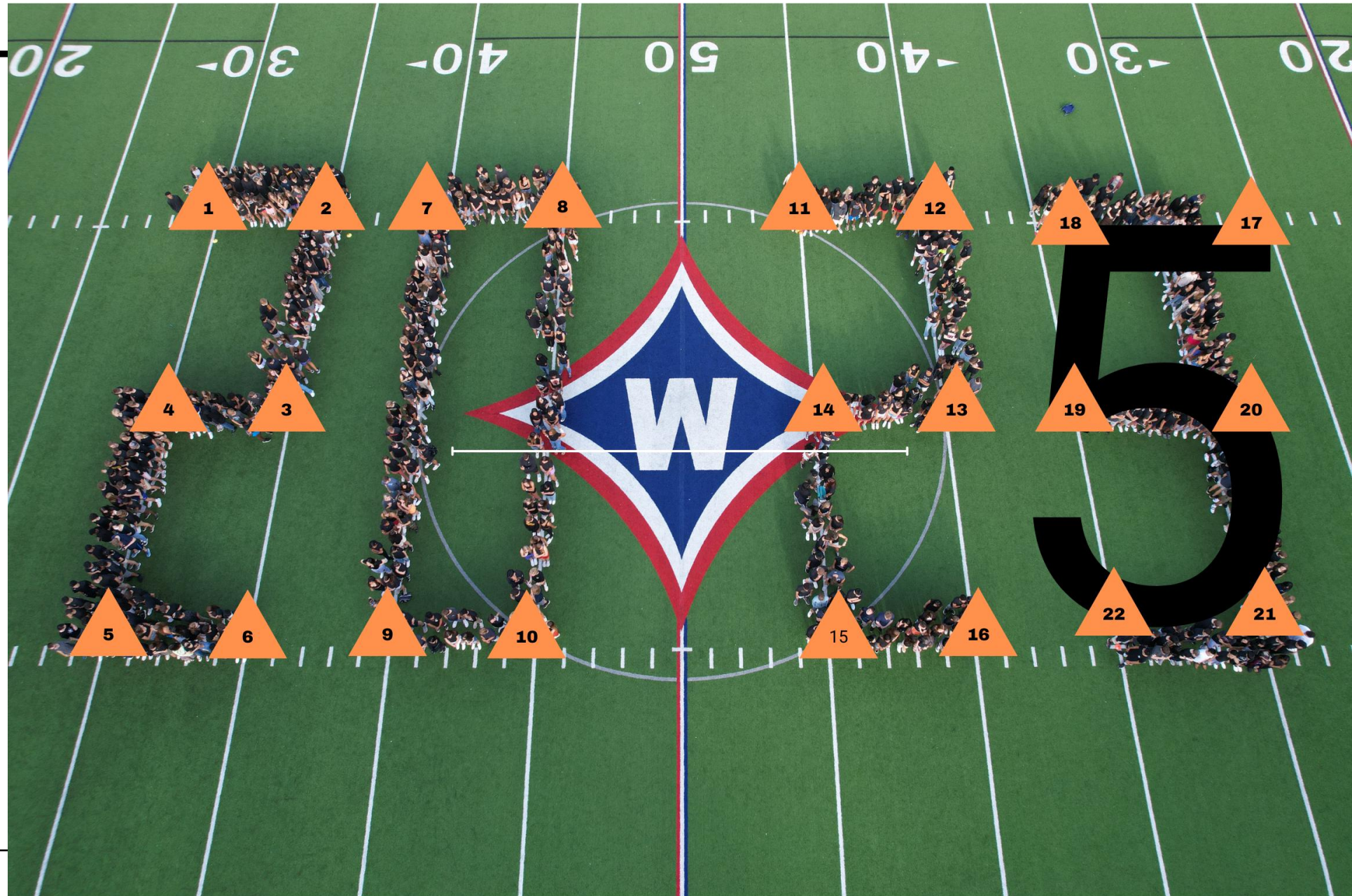

7 CUMULATIVE tardies	Email home to parents
12 CUMULATIVE tardies	WEB Detention Assigned
16 CUMULATIVE tardies	Administrative Referral and Saturday School Assigned
20 CUMULATIVE tardies	Administrative Referral and 1 day of ISS Assigned
20+ CUMULATIVE tardies	Administrative Referral and Increasing discipline assigned by grade level administrator

## Tardies and Sr. Parking

Seniors who park on campus and accumulate 7 unexcused tardies to 1<sup>st</sup> period will have their parking privileges revoked for 5 days. If a senior has 16 unexcused tardies to 1<sup>st</sup> period will have their parking privileges revoked for the rest of the semester.

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# APPROPRIATE ATTIRE

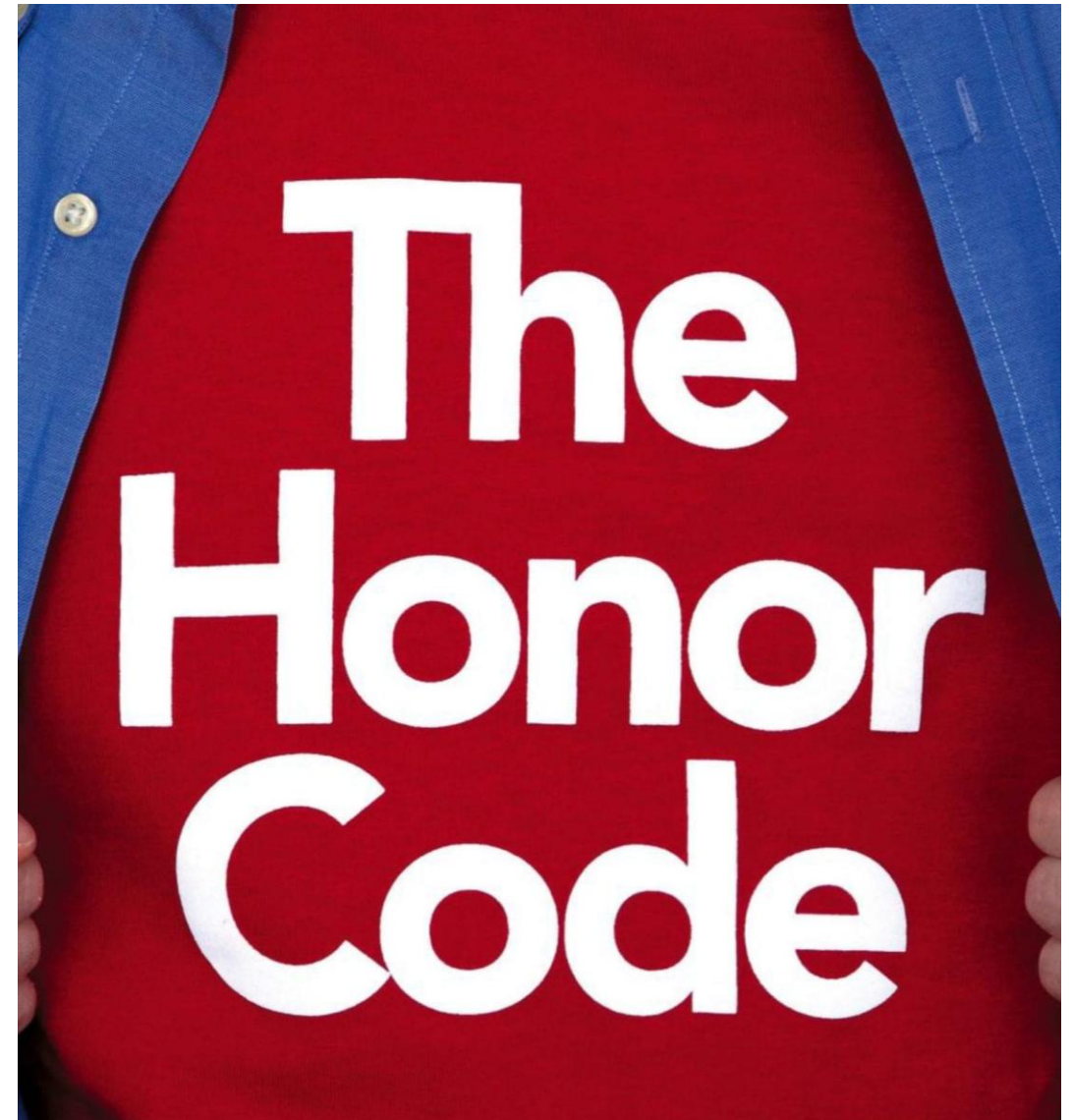


1.
