Advanced Placement:

Sprayberry's Advanced Placement (AP) students took more than 800 exams in 23 courses in 2025. AP classes were offered in Math, Science, English, Social Studies, Fine Arts, and World Languages.

Over 85% of students who took an AP exam at Sprayberry earned a score of three or higher on the exam (this well EXCEEDS the state average).

AP STEM:

Awarded exclusively to schools with students testing in at least two AP math courses AND two science courses.

AP STEM ACHIEVEMENT:

Awarded to schools with students testing in at least two AP math courses AND two AP science courses AND, only when at least 40% of the exam scores on AP math and AP science exams were three or higher.

AP HUMANITIES:

Schools with students testing in all of the following AP courses: at least on ELA course, two social science courses, one fine arts course, and one world language course.

AP MERIT:

Schools with at least 20% of the total student population taking AP exams AND at least 50% of all AP exams earning scores of three or higher.

National, State, and Local Recognition

According to the *U.S. News & World Report*, Sprayberry ranks in the top 15% of schools in the state of Georgia. We attribute this to the strong work ethic of our students, the dedication of our teaching staff, and the support from our community. Statewide, the Georgia Department of Education has denoted Sprayberry as an AP Honor School and has recognized Sprayberry in the following categories: AP Humanities School, AP Merit School, AP STEM School, and AP STEM Achievement School. Sprayberry earned a Platinum Level Award by the Governor's Department of Student Achievement and been named a Georgia School of Excellence. The Platinum Level Award is a prestigious honor awarded to a limited number of schools that demonstrated both the highest achievement and the greatest gains in student performance. We are a CCSD Certified, and Cognia certified STEM school and one of the top schools in the Cobb County School District.

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Athletics:

- Sprayberry Athletics offers 20 different sports teams for Girls and Boys enrolled at Sprayberry High School. Governed by the Georgia High School Association (GHSA), these teams compete during fall, winter, and spring seasons. Our Football, Basketball, Wrestling, Swim and Dive, Soccer, Riflery, and Cheer programs have consistently ranked in region standings and had appearances in state playoffs.
- During the 2025-2026 School year, 21 Seniors, including our first Flag Football player, committed to playing sports at the collegiate level.

Buzz Block:

- One of our top priorities is to prepare students for college and career readiness. We have designed Buzz Block sessions to move students forward academically while giving them time to process curriculum standards and prepare them for rigorous assessments. Students meet for Buzz Block every Wednesday for an opportunity for academic support, remediation, or extracurricular involvement for some of our more time-intensive student groups like Plant Mars, STEM, or Sources of Strength.

Community Service:

- Our Yellow Jackets are highly involved in multiple community service events, including our annual community outreach projects such as Shop with a Yellow Jacket and the Egg Drop. Students can choose from over 30 clubs and organizations, various fine arts groups, and numerous athletic teams where community service is always a priority.

Did you know...

- The Career, Technical, and Agricultural Education (CTAE) program at Sprayberry provides students with hands-on, career-focused learning experiences that prepare them for both college and the workforce. The CTAE program focuses on in-demand careers in Georgia, offering pathways within the career clusters of Digital Technology; Advanced Manufacturing; Hospitality, Events, and Tourism; Arts, Entertainment, and Design; Public Service and Safety; and Healthcare and Human Services. These programs allow students to gain real-world skills in modern, industry-aligned facilities. This impact is reflected in student achievement: in the 2025–2026 school year, 154 students earned pathway completion status by successfully finishing all three courses in their chosen career pathway.
- Sprayberry's Fine Arts programs include Art, Band, Chorus, Drama, and Orchestra.
 - The art program celebrated numerous accolades, including first- and third-place contest wins, multiple public exhibits, and several student scholarships.
 - The band program excelled with major competition titles, honor band selections, state-level recognition, and standout performances by ensembles at major conventions and festivals, alongside strong showings from indoor percussion and winter guard at regional and national events.
 - In choir, students earned top honors with selections to All-State and District Honor Choruses, as well as prestigious opportunities such as the Southern Division ACDA Honor Chorus, the Kaleidoscope Vocal Academy at Yale University, and multiple competition wins, while all choirs received Superior ratings at LGPE.
 - In drama, two students were recognized as GHSA One Act All-Stars.
- The Sprayberry International Spanish Language Academy (ISLA) is the only academy of its kind in the entire state, the four-year program at Sprayberry is truly an exceptional opportunity in that it is open to both native speakers and students who are learning Spanish as a foreign language. As part of the ISLA Program, students will earn the International Skills Diploma Seal and have the opportunity to earn the Bilingual Seal.
- The Sprayberry STEM academy is committed to nurturing young minds and encouraging creativity and innovation. We provide a supportive environment where students can explore, learn, and grow, preparing them for future success in STEM fields and beyond.
- Some highlights for Sprayberry's STEM academy recognition:
 - Our students have won the International NASA competitions Plant the Moon and Plant Mars TWICE, in both best experimental design and most innovative design.
 - Sprayberry STEM students were the first school to generate a student created experiment that was tested aboard the ISS with direct collaboration with Astronaut Don Petit called Fast Labs.
