Daily Expectations- Being Safe.

- You should report anything you see or hear that could be a problem to the nearest adult.
- Always keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
- Anything that you say, should be kind and respectful.
- Do not let anybody into the building.
- Help somebody when they need help.



Daily Expectations- Being Organized.

- Bring all materials needed each day, including a fully charged laptop.
- Keep agenda, pass, eagle card, and folder with you always.
- Arrive time each class on time, every day.
- Clean out bookbags regularly.
- Use your agenda daily.



Daily Expectations- Being Accountable.

- Acknowledge mistakes and don't repeat them.
- Be ENGAGED in classes every day.
- Check CTLS when you are absent.
- Ask teachers questions and for clarification when needed.
- Dedicate time for studying and homework each night.
- Clean up after yourself.



Daily Expectations- Being Respectful.

- Keep hands, feet, and objects to yourself.
- Speak when you have permission in class.
- Use all personal and school property as it was intended.
- Speak only kind words (verbal or written).
- Familiarize yourself with rules and follow them.
- Follow directions from your teachers and staff.



Laptops

- Should be fully charged and brought to school each day.
- These belong to the school district. Treat them accordingly.
- You are responsible for any damage to laptops.
- What you type and search on laptops is not private.
- Do not loan your laptop to another student.
- If repairs are needed, please visit the learning commons.



Cell Phones

- Cell phones should be turned off and not visible all day.
- Eagle card marks will be given.
- You can receive consequences for things you say and do on your phone from home.
- Phones should never be out in the restrooms.
- You can use the office phone if you need to call home.



Dress Code

- Dress code is posted on the website.
- You will be asked to come to the office to call home or change.
- It is your responsibility to be familiar with the dress code.
- If you are in doubt of whether you should wear something or not, you probably shouldn't.
- PE dress code is not much different than regular dress code.



Being Kind

- You are responsible for what you say to someone.
- Being mean to someone repeatedly could be considered harassment or bullying (these come with very big consequences).
- Destruction of school property (vandalism) could result in consequences, paying for damages, and more.
- Make Lost Mountain a fun place for all- be kind and help people when they need help.



Cafeteria

- Know your lunch number.
- Remain seated until it is time to leave.
- Do not touch the food of someone else.
- Do not ask to have someone else's food.
- Make one trip through the lunch line.
- Clean up after yourself.



Restrooms

- Must have your folder with a completed pass to use restrooms.
- Place your folder in one of the racks outside of the restroom.
- Only one folder per rack- Only three people in restroom at a time.
- If all three racks are full, please wait outside of the restroom.
- Report any issues to your teacher.



Hallways

- Walk in the appropriate direction.
- Do not use restrooms during transitions- get pass first.
- If somebody drops something, give them space to pick it up or help them.
- Use appropriate volume when speaking.
- Must have a pass with you if in the hallway during class.



Eagle Cards

- Our way of monitoring “minor” behavior issues.
- Too many marks, will lead to administrative consequences (ISS).
- No marks for 2 weeks, will give you an opportunity to attend SOAR Friday!
- If you lose your eagle card, your marks do not “disappear”.
- You should go to the office if you lose your eagle card.



Academics

- Your performance this year, determines where you're placed next year. Do your best on everything.

- Review the syllabi from your teachers and make sure you understand them.
- Turn work in on time and be prepared for assessments.
