

Requests for Student Teaching Placements Cobb County School District

Observations and Field Experiences

Candidates seeking the opportunity to do field experiences or observations should contact local school administration directly. These requests do not go through the Office of Human Resources.

Student Teaching Placement

Candidates seeking placement for student teaching (practicum) experiences should request that their college or university field placement coordinator contact the Office of Human Resources, at studentteaching@cobbk12.org. Requests are only accepted from colleges or universities, not individual students.

Requests for Student Teaching Placement

College and university field coordinators should send an email request with the following information:

- Candidate Name
- Candidate Email
- Candidate PSC Number
- Degree Program
- Start/End Date of Placement
- Required Hours
- Mentor Requirements
- Current employment within the school district (if applicable)

Candidates who are interested in being considered for placement in the Cobb County School District must complete the CCSD Request for Placement Application. The link for this application is shared with colleges and universities and they will share it with students.

All requests for colleges and universities must be received by the following dates:

- Fall Placement-April 1
- Spring Placement-November 1

Beginning Spring 2024, all applicants must have a pre-service GAPSC certification. Cobb County School District will no longer be providing background checks for student teachers. CCSD will continue to provide background checks for candidates seeking internships in counseling or other fields that do not have preservice GAPSC certification.

Assignment of a Cooperating Teacher

The Office of Human Resources will work carefully with the appropriate college/university field placement coordinator to match approved candidates with a Cooperating Teacher.

Confirmation will be sent to the college/university field placement office and local school administration.
