





How to Subscribe to the Bullard Elementary Calendar:

- From the Bullard Elementary home page scroll down until you see the view calendar link.
- Follow that link to view the calendar

- Once you are in the calendar you can see all upcoming events and important dates.
- If you would like to import the Bullard calendar to your device click on "Calendar Subscriptions"



- Once under the calendar subscriptions tab follow the directions for your device or service.

- Select which events you would like to bring over to your calendar
- Click Subscribe

The text in the box above is your unique calendar subscription. Make sure you copy/paste the entire address exactly as shown into your other calendar. The options below may help make this easier.

Option 1 Copy the subscription address to your clipboard so that it can be pasted somewhere else.

Option 2 Open the subscription address directly (which might open the appropriate program / app).

Option 3 Send yourself an email with subscription address included in the message.

Disclaimers

Microsoft Outlook® Users: Internet Calendar feeds are only supported in version 2007 or later. The calendars will be updated each time Outlook® performs a Send & Receive, which typically happens automatically every 30 minutes (but can also happen on-demand). The live calendar feed from this website has been set to update no more frequently than every 3 hours, however.

Google Calendar™ Users: For several years, many users of Google Calendar have reported that calendar feeds only periodically update from Google, and there is no option to allow the user to update more frequently (or on-demand). Because of this, changes made on the website may or may not appear on your Google calendar immediately.

BlackBerry® Users: For devices running BlackBerry OS 10 (BB10) or higher, the calendar feeds should work just fine. However, prior to BB10 RIM they did not support "over-

This is an example of importing the calendar to a Google calendar.

- Once you click "subscribe" you will be directed to a page like this.
- Copy your subscription address

- In your Google calendar select Add calendar: From URL
- Paste your subscription address in the bar for URL of calendar
- Click Add calendar
