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What is a School-Parent Compact?

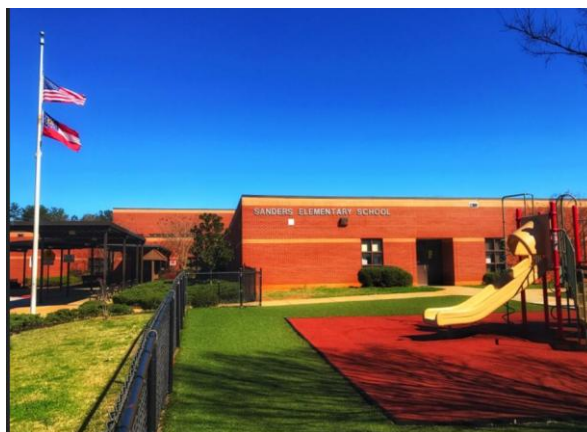

Cobb County School District's Goals for Student Achievement

- ★ By SY26, increase growth by 2 percentage points, for students scoring at the proficient and distinguished levels, as evidenced by state assessments.
- ★ By SY28, increase graduation rate from 87% to 88% as measured by GaDOE adjusted cohort graduation rate.

Sanders Elementary School's Goals for Student Achievement

- ★ Sanders Elementary will increase the number of 3rd through 5th grade students performing on or above grade level from 32% to 35% as measured by the 2025-2026 ELA End-of-Grade Georgia Milestone assessment.
- ★ Sanders Elementary will increase the number of 3rd through 5th grade students performing on or above grade level from 59.5 % in SY25 to 64.5% in SY26 as measured by the Math End-of-Grade Georgia Milestone assessment.

Teachers, Parents, and Students-Together for Success

Sanders Elementary Teachers

Teachers will use CTLS to communicate and provide families access to instructional websites, learning resources and instructional videos to address student needs in reading and math.

Teachers will provide reading comprehension materials for families to utilize with their child at home on their individual reading levels.

Teachers will offer Family Engagement events focused on our school goals. Sanders will offer ELA and Math Nights, and Parent workshops that concentrate on strategies to increase academic achievement.

Sanders Elementary Families

Families will visit CTLS Parent to access websites, learning resources and instructional videos to support their child(ren) at home.

Families will provide a daily reading time, encouraging their child(ren) to use reading comprehension strategies to think about their reading.

Families will attend at least one Family Engagement event per semester, or get information from their child's teacher, parent facilitator, or academic coach to help support their child's academic achievement.

Sanders Elementary Students

Students will access CTLS Learn and all provided learning websites and resources to practice math and reading skills.

Students will read daily while using comprehension, word study and vocabulary strategies.

Students will use activities and resources from Family Engagement events to practice math, problem-solving, and reading comprehension strategies to support their progress in mastering grade-level standards and increasing academic achievement.
