4.	Effectively evaluates student progress in terms of the purposes of the course and grade taught.
5.	Uses knowledge of MIDI concepts, MIDI sequencing software, intelligent software, accompaniment software,
	notation software, and music composition in music technology courses to teach basic music recording concepts
	and operation of music recording equipment.
6.	Engages students in the creation of music utilizing a digital audio workstation.
7.	Assists students in the presentation/performance of their music creations.
8.	Connects students to music industry professionals for future workforce experiences.
9.	Ensures equipment in the music technology lab is maintained properly and repaired when necessary.
10.	Fulfills all responsibilities of paperwork such as materials and equipment inventory, purchase orders, report
	cards, attendance records; meets responsibilities, including presentation of performances, as may be directed
	by the administration.
