9.	Maintains professional competence through in-service education and professional growth activities.
10.	Requisitions and inventories supplies, equipment, and instructional aids in concert with county guidelines.
11.	Communicates with parents, administrators, and school counselors on pupil progress.
12.	Supervises pupils in out-of-classroom activities during the assigned working day.
13.	Participates in faculty committees, the sponsorship of student activities, and curriculum development.
