

- Scoliosis Screening Our annual Scoliosis screening for 6<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will take place October 14<sup>th</sup> and October 16<sup>th</sup>. Students will be screened by Coach Aumann and Coach Robinson during their Connections periods. Any student that has been screened by their doctor or does not wish to be screened must turn in an opt-out form prior to the screening date. - Why Schedule a Conference While attending Open House and accessing <u>ParentVue</u>, <u>PBIS Rewards Family</u>, and <u>CTLS Parent</u> may provide all the information that some parents need, there are still those that should plan to schedule a conference during Conference Week. Here are a few reasons that you should consider signing up for a conference:
  - Your child has missing or incomplete assignments.
  - Grades are below expectations (for example, below 80%) or have recently dropped.
  - Your child is struggling to understand class content or needs extra support.
  - School behaviors are leading to consequences for your child.
  - Your child is having a hard time keeping up with the workload or balancing responsibilities.
  - You've noticed your child feels overwhelmed, stressed, or discouraged about school.
  - You would like strategies to support learning at home.
  - You have questions or concerns about your child's progress or classroom experience.
  - You have concerns about how your child is doing socially in class.


