Fall Picture Retakes – School picture packages were distributed this past Friday (11/14), and picture retakes will take place on Thursday, 11/20. Students are eligible for retakes if they fit into the following categories:

- Students were absent or did not get their photos taken on the original picture day.
- Students are new to Simpson since picture day.
- Students who bought a package and are unhappy with the quality. Those in this category must return the entire package to the photographer on Retake Day.
- Students who want to purchase a package of the Retake Day picture. Order envelopes are available in the Front Office. (Online ordering is not available for Retake Day.)

Early Checkouts – If your child will be checking out early, please send in a note with them and include the time they will be picked up and why they are leaving early. Tell them to turn the note into the office before homeroom and we will give them a pass to come up at the checkout time. Any adult checking out a student must be listed in ParentVue as Release To & Contact Allowed for the student. All adults must show a valid State ID or Driver's License as proof of identity.

Lost and Found – Lost and found bins are located in each grade level's commons area, PE locker rooms, and music classrooms. There are many jackets, hoodies, lunch boxes, water bottles and other items in the bins. Valuable lost items such as glasses, wallets, air pods, phones, jewelry, etc. are brought to the front office. Please remind your child check all areas for any forgotten/lost items.
