Item Dropoff – This is your periodic reminder that we do not interrupt instruction at Simpson for drop-offs. This means that, if your Eagle leaves their laptop, instrument, lunch, etc. at home and you bring it to Simpson, we will put it aside for your student, but we will not call into class to have them come pick it up. With almost 1000 students, this would be a continual disruption to instruction. Students must come to the front office to check for drop-offs between classes.



**Student Checkout** – Any adult checking out a student must be listed in <u>ParentVue</u> as <u>Release To & Contact Allowed</u> for the student. The adult must show a valid State ID or Driver's License as proof of identity. We do not accept electronic copies of ID.
