- **Student Laptop Update** If your 7th or 8th Eagle waits until they return to school to update their CCSD student laptop, it will take a very long time to do so. Now is a good time to charge that device, power it up, get it on a network, and run updates. Instructions for updating can be found Here.
- 6th Grade Student Laptop In order for 6th grade students to receive a CCSD student laptop, parents must opt-in through <u>ParentVue</u>. Laptops will be distributed during the first week of school and only students who are opted in prior to August 1st will be guaranteed a laptop in the first round of distributions. - 6th Grade Instrument Test Drive During the first week of the school year our 6th grade students will go through a rotation to learn about all our connections classes including band, chorus, and orchestra. We expect every 6th grade student to choose at least one of these music programs. Remember, students need NO previous musical experience to join one of these programs and the start of 6th grade is the ONLY opportunity to join one of these amazing groups at Simpson! Please go ahead and mark your calendar for Saturday, August 9. That day will be our instrument test drive, the best time to determine which of our ensembles are the best fit for your Eagle.
- **School Supplies** Pre-ordered school supplies will be available for pickup at <u>Soaring Day</u>. If your family did not pre-order, see the <u>2025-26 Simpson Supply List</u> to help you prepare.
- Cell Phones At Simpson, our policy regarding personal electronic devices (cell phones, headphones, etc) is that students may have them, but they must be in their backpack. Students are only allowed to use these personal electronic devices with explicit teacher permission. The Simpson Personal Electronics Protocol will be followed for students who are using devices without teacher permission.
