PBIS Rewards Family A letter with a scannable QR code will be coming out this coming week. (Be sure to check your spam!) Celebrating your student's positive points is a great way to reinforce the school's message at home. Digital Learning Day – One week from tomorrow, Monday, August 19, is a Digital Learning Day for all CCSD students. This means that they DO NOT report to school but DO have schoolwork. Students should access CTLS for each class to see the work outlined for them. This will primarily be a review of previous material or a preview of what is upcoming. That day, our entire staff will be at Simpson collaboratively planning. So, both students and parents should feel free to reach out to teachers for questions and additional support. Parents, Digital Learning Days are a great time to check ParentVue to see if your student has any missing assignments!

Operational

Student Advisory Council – If your Eagle is looking to take on a leadership role at Simpson this year, they can apply to become a member of the 2025-26 Simpson Student Advisory Council. This group works directly with school administration to contribute to decisions made for the school. The application deadline is the end of the school day Friday, 8/22.

Laptop Chargers – Now that the vast majority of our 6th grade students have received their CCSD laptop, please remind them of the following:

- Students should always bring their charged laptop to Simpson everyday.
- Although the charged laptop should last the entire day, students should also bring their power supply.

Student Laptop Notes – Just like any technology in your household, there should be a system for supervision and maintenance of the CCSD Student Laptop. See notes below for establishing your plan.

- Network Access: While on the CCSD network, students have restricted access to sites that they should not be accessing. However, on your home network, they can access whatever your network allows. The security of what they can and can't view comes from the network, not the laptop itself. This is something to consider when planning for when, where, and how they use their laptops at home.
- Screen Time: Just like TV or cellphones, too much screen time on the laptop is not good for young brains. For this reason, we recommend that you established an off time for the CCSD student laptop. At that time, the laptop should be stored somewhere visible and plugged in.
- Charging: The CCSD laptop is an integral learning tool for students throughout each day. For this reason, it should come to school fully charged each day. Thank you for determining a location in your household where this can occur each evening.

School Clubs – Many student clubs and organizations will exist this year at Simpson. Over the month of August, we will be forming this year's groups and advertising them through our daily student broadcast and this newsletter. Clubs will begin meeting following Labor Day weekend. Cell Phones – At Simpson, our policy regarding personal electronic devices (cell phones, headphones, etc) is that students may have them, but they must be in their backpack. Students are only allowed to use these personal electronic devices with explicit teacher permission. The Simpson Personal Electronics Protocol will be followed for students who are using devices without teacher permission.

Dress Code – In preparation for the schoolyear it may be beneficial to review the Simpson Dress Code.


