PBIS Field Trip — We have set dates for our PBIS Rewards field trip to Stars and Strikes, which can be seen in the upcoming dates at the bottom of this newsletter. The cost of the trip will be 250 PBIS Points plus a cash payment that is TBD but is typically \$10-15. Funds from Color Battle help supplement the trip and keep it very inexpensive for students. The cutoff for purchasing the trip in PBIS Rewards is Friday, 12/13. Students need to look under Events in the PBIS Rewards App to purchase the trip with their points. Because this is a trip to recognize positive behavior, students can strike out of the trip if they have three strikes between 11/4 and the date of the trip.

Morning Drop Off Reminders – Please remember the following when dropping off students in the morning:

- Students can be dropped off anywhere along the curb as seen <u>Here</u>. They do not need to be right at the door to exit the car as they are young and healthy and capable of making the walk!
- Please only drop off at the curb and not in the center lane. Drop off in the center lane forces students to cross traffic, an unsafe situation that is not worth the seconds you save.
- Please do not park in the drop off lane and wait until 8:00 to unload. If you would like to wait until 8:00, please find a parking space and then loop back through the line once doors open. This will allow others to drop off their Mavericks at the curb from 7:45-8:00.
