These tests are taken 100% on a computer. This allows for faster scoring and reporting of results. In addition, taking the test on the computer offers students many additional tools that paper and pencil testing does not, including a calculator built into the system. At this site, your student can see what the online testing portal looks like and get comfortable with the online tools. There are also practice tests available for students.
