Throughout the school year, the McClure Team works hard evaluating student data within each instructional unit to assure students are learning. We then work very hard to provide intervention opportunities for students who do not master content the first time around. We believe that the most important tests we administer are these assessments within each unit during the year. However, there is no denying the importance of the Milestones Assessments. Scores on these tests are a measure of how successful a school is as compared to other schools across the state. For this reason, we want our students to take these tests seriously, and give 110% effort when it is their turn to show what they know. Good test scores of course validate the hard work we do at McClure, but they are also good for the whole community as they can positively impact our CCRPI scores and therefore impact property value!

Student Laptop Chargers – Milestones Testing is starting soon. It is important that your student's charged laptop is at school every day. If your student has lost their charger a replacement must be purchased. There are a variety of sources to purchase from, including Amazon. This charger will work with both current models of student laptops (many 6th graders have laptops that can also be charged with a USB C charger). If you order from another source, look for a charger compatible with a dell latitude 3190 laptop of 65W with round power connectors. The connector must be 7.4mm across (many other adapters are 4.5mm size and will not work with your student's laptop).



7th Grade Vaccinations – All rising 7th grade students are required to have one dose of the Tdap and meningococcal vaccines to attend school. Once your child has received the required vaccines, please send a copy of the completed Georgia Department of Public Health Certificate of Immunization Form 3231 to McClure. It can be emailed to McclureMSSupport@cobbk12.org or dropped off at the front office. Per Georgia law, a completed immunization record must be on file for your child by the first day of the 2024-2025 school year.
