Heads Up

Student Laptop – With our 6th grade students receiving CCSD student laptops, there are a couple of notes we feel are important for all parents to consider:

Access to Content:

- At school, when students are on the CCSD network, what they have access to is limited and students have great difficulty trying to access age-inappropriate content.
- At home, on your home Wi-Fi, students can access anything that your network allows. There are few filters on the CCSD laptop that control what comes through a browser once it is on your home network (and students are incredibly talented at working around the filters that exist).

• Do you have a system to monitor how your network is being used at home? <u>Supervision:</u>

- Just like a cell phone, online gaming, or the smart TV, 11–14-year-old children should not be left to access whatever they want without supervision.
- The same should be true with the student laptop. If they are using it, it should be in an area of the house that adults are supervising.

Screen Time:

- Infinite screen time is not good for any student, especially middle school students.
- What is your household's system for the time of day that the laptop is turned off and put on its charger in a pace in the house that can be seen by adults?

- Clinic Medication CCSD has updated the procedures for the 2024-2025 school year requiring all prescription medication to have the healthcare provider's signature on the <u>Authorization to Administer Medication Form JGCD-2</u> (Spanish). In order for the school nurse to administer the medication(s) to a student, the parent must provide <u>The Form</u> (Spanish) signed by both the healthcare provider and the parent. The prescription label's administration instructions must match what is on the signed form. No prescription medication can be accepted into the clinic until <u>Form JGCD-2</u> (Spanish) is completed. An MD signature is not required for over-the-counter medication.
- **Updating Contacts** Did you know you can update your contacts in <u>ParentVue</u>? This allows you to adjust who can check your Maverick out of school, who can see education records, and more. See <u>These How-to Steps</u> to update your Maverick's contact information ASAP!
- Laptop Chargers It is often beneficial to have an extra charger at home for the student laptop. Use the links below to order one for your Maverick:

 - 7th Grade: <u>Dell Laptop Charger 65W Watt USB Type C</u>
 - 6th Grade: Lenovo USB Type C Charger
- Item Drop-off At McClure, we do not interrupt instructional time for items that are dropped off for students. Therefore, item drop-off should only occur in emergency situations. Middle school students are at the age when it is a good time to learn the hard lesson of, "Oops, I left that at home. I'd better remember it next time." Students will be fine at school without the following items being dropped off to them: Musical instrument, student laptop, PE clothes, and lunch (we will make sure they get lunch).
