For US History

Students currently in US History will take the EOC on Friday, December 3rd. There are 2 sections and students will complete both sections at one time.

This year, the EOC will count for 20% of your final grade so it is very important that you take it on the required date and do your best!

Here are a few things to know and a few tips:

- Your teacher will let you know where to go (and which block) to test when it gets closer to the EOC date. If you still aren't sure where to go a few days before, ask your teacher!
- All EOCs will be given face-to-face at McEachern. There is no remote option.
- We will socially distance and spread out as much as possible.
- If you do not take the EOC, teacher must enter a 0 (zero) that counts toward 20% of your final grade.
- Get plenty of rest the night before your testing dates!
- Eat a healthy breakfast on the morning of your testing dates so that you have plenty of energy.
