

Certificate Programs

Considerations

- Entry Level Workforce Technical Certificates can be accomplished without a high school diploma.
- Most programs are one year or less.
- Courses meet specific employment requirements.
- Credits may be applied to other technical certificates or diploma programs.
- Very few options for on-campus housing.
- Costs vary.

Paying for Certificate Programs

HOPE Career Grant

- Tuition-free programs in 18 high-demand career fields.
- Not all campuses have all programs.
- Students do not need to have a specific GPA leaving high school.
- Can be a part-time or full-time student.
- Other requirements apply.
 - Automotive Technology
 - Certified Engineer Assistant
 - Computer Programming
 - Construction Technology
 - Early Childhood Care and Education
 - Health Science
 - Logistics/Transportation Technology
 - Practical Nursing
 - Welding and Joining Technology

- Aviation Technology

- Commercial Truck Driving Computer Technology Diesel Equipment Technology Electrical Lineman Technology
- Industrial Maintenance
- Movie Production Set Design
- Precision Manufacturing
- Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice



Accessing Accommodations

Technical College System of Georgia

- $_{\odot}$ Apply and receive acceptance
- \circ Self-disclose to the Student Disability Office
- ${\rm \circ}$ Provide required documentation
- \odot Complete intake session with Disability Office
- $_{\odot}$ Advocate for approved accommodations



Training Programs

Considerations

- Training is job/career specific.
- Some programs offer certifications.
- The training period is shorter than a college experience.
- Some programs include employability skills and job assistance.
- Very few options for on-campus housing.
- Cost and financial aid vary.
